

# Spectator Carts:

The OHSA has adopted [guidelines for assistance for spectators who are ADA disabled](#).

- If a spectator needs motorized assistance to view the tournament, they must contact the site manager at least 48 hours in advance of the tournament.
- The manager will make an attempt to line up a cart driver for the individual. Due to the limited number of individual drivers that may be available, requests will be processed on a "first come, first served" basis.
- If a driver cannot be secured, tournament management will provide transportation to a viewing spot for the individual.
- Periodically, a marshal will move the individual to another viewing location.
- Those requesting a motorized cart must provide official documentation supporting the indicated disability. (Such as a handicapped placard)
- Tournament management will not be expected to provide a cart driver if they have not received advance notification of the spectator's need.
- If a driver is provided, the cost of the use of the cart is up to the individual course and will be paid for by the spectator.

- **Under no circumstances will a spectator be provided a cart for personal use**
