- 1. Format: 18 Stroke Play,
- 2. U.S.G.A. Rules of Golf will govern all play except for the following local rules:
 - You will receive free relief within one club length, no nearer the hole, from roads, cart paths, tree stumps, debris piles,
 - Ground under repair is marked with white paint.
 - All heather will be treated as a lateral hazard.

 (Specimen Local Rule Water Hazard: Ball Played Provisionally Under Rule 261) Heather will be defined as any rough over 1-2 foot. If
 unsure consult with your marker. This also includes left trees
 and trees behind on holes 12, 13 and left by the 15th green and
 behind the 15th green.
 - Free drop from animal damage
- 3. The embedded ball rule is in effect through the green.
- 4. The fourteen-club rule is in effect.
- 5. All play for Boys from Blue tees and Girls from Red.
- 6. You may get relief from casual water
- 7. Each group is expected to keep up with the group in front of them. **Pace of play policy will apply**.
- 8. Internal out of bounds will apply for #10 which will be out of bounds when you are playing #9
- 9. Your round is not complete until you have signed and handed in your scorecard. Reminder you can consult with your coach during the hole.
- 10. Range finders will be allowed (only if it meets requirements).
- 11. Drop zone on #11 is from beginning of fairway, and to the right the 18th green for the heather behind the right of the 18th green.
- 12. All decisions will be made by the Rules Committee.
