

PICKAWAY COUNTRY CLUB
COURSE RULES
2023

1. USGA rules govern all play. Girls Gold Tees. Ball played down (determine on match day). All high grass will be played as lateral - marked or unmarked. ALL flower beds – free drop – stance and swing relief.
2. “Out of Bounds” is defined by white lines and all fence lines surrounding the property. Stoutsville Pike, entry way, and parking lot, is also OB. Lines and stakes identify. Driving Range by 16 – 17 – 18. Stroke and distance
3. Ground Under Repair – Areas may white lines or not. See Marshall for ruling. Procedure: Rule 25-1
4. In sand traps – Rake and place ball – no penalty
5. Lateral Hazards – defined by red lines and stakes. If both are present, lines define and stakes identify. Optional drops have been provided on #3 across from pond, and #9 (behind green), and on #18 across from pond.
6. Water Hazards- defined by yellow lines (may not be marked). Optional drop zones have been provided for on #3 and #18.
7. All lines on course are the ultimate deciding factor on course.
8. All cart paths are a free drop no closer to the hole.(one club length)
Loose asphalt or materials around cart paths can be moved.
9. Parking lot and Road on #3 and #18 are OB
- 10.No Caddying Allowed. NO ONE is to carry the bag or push cart (except player) during competition !!!! No bag on coach’s cart or spectator cart at any time

Hole by Hole Rules

- #1 OB to the right down the fence line/Lateral Hazard on left(pond and tree line).
- #2 OB on road – Creek is a water hazard (yellow) High grass on left-Lateral
- #3 Pond is a water hazard(yellow)(Drop area on other side of pond) / The entry road and parking lot is OB.
- #4 The pond is a lateral hazard on left side / The fence line behind the green is OB. High grass on left or right -Lateral
- #5 OB down left tree line -high grass on right - Lateral
- #6 OB down left tree line. High grass near green on left- Lateral
- #7 – high grass on right – Lateral
- #8 – High grass on left -Lateral
- #9 The woods to the left are an unmarked area of the course, if ball is lost in the woods, you must re-tee. Behind green high grass lateral...There is a drop area BEHIND GREEN.
- #10 High grass on left – Lateral
- #11 high grass near green on right- Lateral
- #12 – High grass on left-Lateral
- #13 OB left and over green. Creek Lateral
- #14 OB left (fence row all) and over green OB (fence)
- #15 OB down left side / Area through the fairway is a red hazard.
- #16 Left from tee to bridge is a red hazard / Left from bridge to green is OB /Right from tee to creek is a red hazard(both side) / right from creek to green(driving range) is OB.
DO NOT HIT RANGE BALLS WITH CLUB
- #17 Road to left is OB / Driving range to right is OB
DO NOT HIT RANGE BALLS WITH CLUB
- #18 Road to left all the way to the green is OB / Driving range to the right is OB / Creek to right of lower fairway is a red hazard. Parking lot OB. Drop area in water across from pond.
DO NOT HIT RANGE BALLS WITH CLUB
