

**2018 Division II East District Sectional
Cadiz Country Club
Information & Rules Sheet**

Rules & Information:

- 1) All USGA and OHSAA Rules are in effect / These are readily available online through the OHSAA website. Coaches and players are responsible to know these rules
- 2) White Tees
- 3) Summer Rules (Play the ball down everywhere)
- 4) Areas in the fairway with no grass will be played as Ground Under Repair all other GUR have been marked
- 5) Rules question, play two balls and seek a ruling at the conclusion of play.
- 6) If you hit a ball in the woods, hit a provisional ball and then look for it (5 minutes to look for lost balls)
- 7) Red Stakes / Lateral Hazard – most common options at CCC
 - a) Play the ball as it lies, no penalty. (Cannot ground club in hazard)
 - b) Re-hit with one shot penalty from the previous spot
 - c) Drop two club lengths from point of entry, no closer to the hole, with one shot penalty.
 - d) Keep point of entry and hole in line and drop with one shot penalty no nearer to the hole.
- 8) Cell phones are not permitted during play. Phones in a player's possession must be turned off and be out of sight during the round. Penalties imposed may result in disqualification.
- 9) Range finders are permitted, provided they are not part of a communication device and meet the rules set by the USGA
- 10) No coaches or spectator carts will be permitted (*exceptions available for ADA)
- 11) Players are not to communicate in any way with spectators. Please keep your distance.

Hole by hole hazards:

All Hazards are marked

#1 Red Stakes right	#2 Red Stakes right & left
#3 Red Stakes left & Long	#4 Red Stakes left
#5 Red Stakes left	#6 None
#7 Red Stakes left	#8 Red Stakes left
#9 Red Stakes left	#10 Red Stakes right (by green)
#11 Red Stakes left	#12 Red Stakes left (by green)
#13 None	#14 Red Stakes left (by green)
#15 Red Stakes left	#16 Red Stakes left & right
#17 None	#18 Red Stakes right

Out of bounds – Off club property: Hole #1 (road, tree line by green), #12, #13, #14 (Fence Line)

-Exchange scorecards before beginning play. (Be sure no two people are keeping each other's scores.)

-Mark and identify your Golf Ball before play.

-At the conclusion of play, go immediately to the back patio and have a seat at the scoring table.

-Do not sign your card until you are with the scorer.

All rules are subject to change based on course conditions. Players will get an updated rule sheet at their tee time
