

**2019 Division II East District Sectional
Cadiz Country Club
Information & Rules Sheet**

Rules & Information:

- 1) All USGA and OHSAA Rules are in effect / These are readily available online through the OHSAA website. Coaches and players are responsible to know these rules
- 2) White Tees
- 3) Summer Rules (Play the ball down everywhere)
- 4) Through the green, a ball that is embedded may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, as near as possible to the spot where it lay but not nearer the hole.
- 5) Rules question, play two balls declaring which you want to score if allowed and seek a ruling at the conclusion of play.
- 6) If you hit a ball in the woods, identify and hit a provisional ball and then look for it (3 minutes to look for lost balls)
- 7) Red Staked Penalty Areas – most common options at CCC
 - a) Play the ball as it lies, no penalty.
 - b) Drop two club lengths from point of entry, no closer to the hole, with one shot penalty.
 - c) Re-hit with one shot penalty from the previous spot
- 8) Cell phones are not permitted during play. Phones in a player's possession must be turned off and be out of sight during the round. Penalties imposed may result in disqualification.
- 9) Range finders are permitted, provided they are not part of a communication device and meet the rules set by the USGA
- 10) No coaches or spectator carts will be permitted (*exceptions available for ADA)
- 11) Players are not to communicate in any way with spectators. Please keep your distance.

Hole by hole hazards:

All red penalty areas are marked with red painted lines.

#1 Red penalty area right	#2 Red penalty area right & left
#3 Red penalty area left & long	#4 Red penalty area left
#5 Red penalty area left	#6 None
#7 Red penalty area left	#8 Red penalty area left
#9 Red penalty area left	#10 Red penalty area right (by green)
#11 Red penalty area left	#12 Red penalty area left (by green)
#13 None	#14 Red penalty area left (by green)
#15 Red penalty area left	#16 Red penalty area left & right
#17 None	#18 Red penalty area right

Out of bounds – Off club property: Hole #1 (Left of Tree Line), #12, #13, #14 (Fence Line)

All OB areas are marked with white painted lines (Penalty – Stroke and Distance)

-Exchange scorecards before beginning play. (Be sure no two people are keeping each other's scores.)

-Mark and identify your Golf Ball before play.

-At the conclusion of play, go immediately to the back patio and have a seat at the scoring table.

-Do not sign your card until you are with the scorer.
