

Boys Division II Sectional Tournament

Rules

- USGA and OHSAA rules will govern all play today.
- Players will play the **white** tees.
- Out of bounds, defined by white stakes, on holes 18, 19, 20, 21, 27
- Red penalty area, defined by red lines, on holes 10 and 18 and the river behind 21 green
- The high grass or unmowed areas are played as red penalty areas, defined by red lines.
- The water on #16 and #27 is a yellow penalty area, defined a yellow line.
- Bunkers: play the ball as it lies, then smooth out the sand with your foot or club after completing your shot.
- Flagsticks shall be left in the hole at all times.
- Local rule for ball deflected by power line: If a player's ball strikes a power line, guy wire, or pole, the player must replay the stroke from a spot nearest to where the original ball was played.
- If in doubt of a rule, play two balls, record both scores, and inform the rules committee when your round is complete.
- Slow play will not be tolerated and will be monitored.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. A warning will be given on the first offense, two stroke penalty for a second offense, and disqualification on the third offense.
- Scores will be posted unofficially at the turn
- Suspension of play: in case of inclement weather, suspension of play will be signaled by three short siren blasts. Players must discontinue play, mark their position on the course, and take shelter. Resumption of play will be signaled by one prolonged siren blast.
- Scoring: after play is completed, players will proceed to the pro shop patio. Scorecards will not be exchanged. Players will verbally read off scores to the tournament committee and be attested by the other players in the group. Results will be posted on baumspage.com.
