

COVID-19 Coach & Player Protocols

1. Prior to departing for the golf course, it is each coach's responsibility to conduct COVID-19 symptom checks for his/her team. Any golfer and/or coach exhibiting symptoms should be sent home immediately and should not be transported to the golf course. Please complete the attached COVID-19 monitoring form and turn it in at the golf course. These forms will be requested by the county health department should contact tracing need to take place.
2. Facial coverings are required when on your transportation vehicle and should be worn throughout the day except when the players are warming up and competing. Coaches should wear facial coverings throughout the day and when they are unable to maintain a distance of 6 feet.
3. In addition to bringing snacks and facial coverings, players are encouraged to bring their own personal hand sanitizer.
4. Remind your players to practice social distancing as much as possible while they are at and on the golf course. Do not gather on the tee boxes or near the holes. We need to avoid large congregations of players and coaches.
5. Players and coaches should refrain from entering the clubhouse as much as possible. Restrooms are available in the clubhouse and on the golf course. **If clubhouse entry is necessary, facial coverings are required at all times.**
6. Each team will have a range/practice green reservation, as well as a tee time. **Teams must remain in the vehicle until their designated practice time.**
7. Upon arrival, the coach will check in his/her team at the cart staging area (at the north end of the building). Coaches will be given a packet that contains tournament rules and scorecards. Please review the rules with your individual team. We will not be having a coaches meeting or large group gathering to go over the rules.
8. Once checked in, coaches may pick up their assigned cart outside of the clubhouse. Range balls for the team will be located on the cart. You will use the same cart throughout the day. Coaches are responsible for returning their cart to the staging area once their team has finished.
9. Upon arrival at the tee, players should introduce one another and identify each other's golf balls. No exchanging of scorecards; each player should keep score for everyone in the group using provided scorecards. At the completion of the round, each group should verbally verify scores hole-by-hole. This verification should take place away from others. Once scores are agreed upon by all players in the group, each player should immediately return to their team's transportation vehicle. Scorecards do not need to be signed and attested. Coaches will collect their teams' scorecards at the vehicle and verify each scorecard's accuracy. Coaches are then responsible for returning all completed verified scorecards to a tournament official located in the pro shop.
10. Teams should depart the golf course as soon as all scorecards are turned in (unless one of your athletes has the possibility of participating in a playoff). There will be no scoreboard or awards ceremony. Results of the event will be emailed to each coach, athletic director and to the media.
