Attention Golf Coach:

The 2023 Boys Division I Sectional Golf Tournament will be played at Tannenhauf Golf Club on **Tuesday**, **October 3, 2023 starting at 8:30 AM**. Rain date: Wednesday, October 4.

- The OHSAA is utilizing the OHSAA Golf app powered by iWanamaker to provide live scoring for the sectional, district, and state tournaments, but will continue to use the Baumspage Online Entry System and Mobile Golf Tournament Application to provide the traditional support for all sectional and district golf tournaments this fall.
- 2. For 2023 rosters will need to be submitted on both the OHSAA Golf app and Baumspage.
- 3. Results will be posted live on the OHSAA Golf app or www.iwanamaker.com

For the **OHSAA** Golf app:

- 1. If you haven't already done so, all coaches and players will need to install OHSAA Golf app on their mobile devices and create an account on IWanamaker.
 - a. If you haven't used the **OHSAA Golf** app, click the **Getting Started** link.
 - b. See **OHSAA Golf App powered by iWanamaker** on the second page for additional information.
 - c. After creating your account, click **Help** to select the **Roster Management** link and view the YouTube video.
 - d. If you haven't used the OHSAA Golf app, you can set up a practice meet and have golfers enter scores.
- 2. Before the sectional, log in to your <u>iWanamaker</u> account and click **Roster** to view the Seed Numbers for your athletes...
 - a. Use **Edit** as needed to ensure the **Seed** numbers match your intended playing order!
 - b. Please edit the name to proper case If their names are either all caps or all lowercase.

.For Baumspage:

- 1. To submit your roster on **Baumspage** you will need to create an account. Please do so early!
 - a. The entry window will open at 8:00 AM, Sunday, September 10.
 - b. The online window will close at 9:00 AM, Monday, October 2...
 - c. User accounts and passwords from last year were retained. Associations with sports were cleared.
- Click the Online Entry link at www.baumspage.com/golf/.
 - a. Click on Login if you already have an account or Apply to create a new account!
 - i) To apply, provide the data requested, check the "I'm not a robot" button, and Submit.
 - b. Use Coaches | Select Teams to select your School and Sport.
 - i) On Select School Type | select High School | click Get Schools/Clubs
 - ii) Highlight your school | click Get Available School Teams
 - iii) On Select Sport select HS Boys Golf | click Make me the Coach
 - c. Use Coaches | Golf | Modify Athletes to enter your alphabetic roster.
 - d. Use Coaches | Golf | Submit Rosters to enter the tournament.
 - i) Select golfers in playing order and click **Submit Roster** to submit!
 - ii) Make sure that the players are submitted in the same order as their Seed order on the OHSAA Golf app!
 - e. Use the Contact Us link on Baumspage if there are problems.
- 3. Pairings, tee times, and tournament results will be posted on baumspage and the OHSAA Golf app.

Registering as a golf coach, AD, golfer or spectator is done with the OHSAA Golf app from the app store. ADs, Coaches and Golfers are added automatically to their respective schools when they get the OHSAA Golf app powered by iWanamaker from the app store. Please install the app and during the registration process you will be added to your school with the correct role.

After you register using the OHSAA Golf app you will go to https://www.iwanamaker.com to manage your schedule and roster. To navigate to your school you can click on LEAGUES then Ohio High Athletic Association and find your school.

Spectators: Please advise parents

- The price of admission for all sectional and district tournaments shall be \$8. All tickets must be purchased online at: <u>www.ohsaa.org/tickets</u>.
 Children under the age of five are provided complimentary admission.
- 2. Results will be posted live on the OHSAA Golf app by iWanamaker
 - a) Parents wishing to follow the live scoring will need to install the OHSAA Golf App on their smartphone or the iWanamaker app on their computer.
 - b) To view they will need to purchase a ticket or pass.
 - c) Click the link OHSAA Golf App Event and Season Pass Information for details and pricing.
- 3. Spectator carts will be permitted to handicapped individuals ONLY. Carts must remail ½ hole ahead or behind the group they are following. No player may ride in a golf cart unless directed to do so by a Tournament official.
- 4. Spectators walking the course must remain ½ hole ahead or behind the tee group they are following.

Greens Fee: Participating schools will not be charged green fees for competition rounds of play. Call pro shop for practice rounds and fees.

Rules:

- A. The Rules of Golf, as approved by the United States Golf Association and R & A, for Stroke Play and OHSAA tournament regulations shall prevail for all tournaments sponsored by the OHSAA.
- B. The Rules of Golf include an optional Local Rule that allows players to drop a ball with 2 penalty strokes in an area near where the ball was lost or estimated to go out of bounds. The Local Rule is not one of the 24 Rules of Golf; it is an optional Local Rule. This 2-stroke optional Local Rule may NOT be used at the OHSAA Sectional, District, or State tournaments.
- C. OHSAA Local Rule Sectional Tournaments Only Maximum allowable score of 12 strokes shall be used during OHSAA tournament play at the sectional level. Should a player reach 12 strokes on a hole, the player shall stop play on that hole and record their score as a 12. A player's score who has used the 12-stroke limit may still contribute their score to a team / individual score.

Coaches: Please review with the members of your team the information found in the **2023 OHSAA Golf Regulations** and the **2023 OHSAA Tournament Golf Regulations** along with any other communications on Golf from the OHSAA.
