

## **COVID-19 Spectator Protocols**

1. Spectators are limited and must have a pre-purchased ticket to enter the grounds. Spectators may show up no more than 15 minutes prior to their players tee time. You will NOT be allowed to enter until then. All spectators must walk.
2. Spectators must sign in at the table near the clubhouse (necessary if the Board of Health needs to do contact tracing).
3. Spectators must consent to a temperature and COVID-19 symptom check before being permitted on the course.
4. Spectators must wear a facial covering at all times in and around the clubhouse and when social distancing is not available on the course.
5. Spectators must avoid congregating in large groups near the players and coaches. No spectators will be allowed on the range or putting green. Any conversations with players during a round are cause for disqualification.
6. Spectators must leave the facility immediately following their players round, not the entire teams round. There will be no scoreboard or awards ceremony so there is no need to stay. If there is a chance at a playoff for your player, you must wait at your vehicle until the playoff is to start. Only the players designated spectators and team are allowed to follow any playoff.
7. Spectators must wait out any weather delays in their vehicle and re-check in prior to entering the grounds.
8. There is extremely limited parking at Pine Hills. Spectators will need to park on the North side of St. Colette Church or possibly on South Canyon Trail next to Pine Hills. Please pay attention to what side of the road you are allowed to park on. You will be towed if you park wrong.
9. Please turn cell phones to silent and refrain from using them on the course.
10. Spectators not following these rules will be asked to leave immediately.

Please remember we are doing this so the kids can play golf. This is, by far, the largest District tournament in the state and although it is played outside, the facilities cannot support a large number of extra people in and around the clubhouse in a safe manner.
