

2021 Boys' Division Sectional Rules

Format: Stroke Play

Rules of Play: U.S.G.A., OHSAA, and local rules are in effect.

Tees: Blue Tees

Fall Rules are in effect:

- Relief (one club length) from ground under repair. Any area that is circled in white paint. Relief (one club length) from all cart paths, railroad ties, stoned areas and surface drains related to drainage.
- Play it as it lies
- 2 left fairway bunkers on #6 are ground under repair hazards

Water Hazards: Proceed under rule #26

- In front of #1 green, front of #2 tee, left of #3, front of #4 green, front of #9 tee, behind #10, left of #11, front of #13 tee, left of #13 fairway, left of #15, behind #16, front of #17, front of #18 tee and around #18 green.
- * No relief from the railroad ties in the hazard on #18.
- If you land in the water on #18, if the ball goes in before the bridge drop where it crossed the hazard, if the ball goes in past the bridge there is a drop area on the back side of #18 green (white circle).
- Drop areas are located behind #9, #10, #11, #16 and #18 green. Drop area for #11 for the lateral hazard is located just in front of Senior Tee.
- Yellow paint is water hazard
- Red paint is lateral hazard

Out of Bounds: Proceed under rule #27 (defined by white stakes).

- Stroke and Distance Penalty
- Left of #4, over #5 green, left of #6 and #7, left and right of #13, left of #14, right of #16 and right of #17.
- Left of #6, all landscaping is out of bounds.

Local Rule: Free relief from 100, 150, 200, and 250 yardage plates.

Scoring: Scoring will take place in the simulator area.

- After finishing their round, players should verify scores verbally
- Players will sign scorecards and turn them into their coach who will add the scores and turn them into the scoring area.

*If you have any rules questions play two balls and a decision will be made when you come in. Make sure to get the ruling before you sign the scorecard.

Warm Up Guidelines

Range Time: 8:00-8:20

- Bath, Elmwood, Liberty-Benton, Bryan, Kenton, Paulding

Range Time: 8:30-8:50

- Ottawa-Glandorf, Napoleon, Coldwater, Upper Sandusky, Van Wert
- Each team should only use 1-2 alleys at most to ensure all teams have space
- Teams will get an equal number of balls
- We will pick the range between the two sessions
- The teams not using the range will have use of the putting/chipping greens at those times
