 - a) Parents wishing to follow the live scoring will need to install the OHSAA Golf App on their smartphone or the iWanamaker app on their computer.
 - b) To view they will need to purchase a ticket or pass.
 - c) Click the link OHSAA Golf App Event and Season Pass Information for details and pricing.
- A limited number of carts may be available for spectators. Check with the pro shop. Carts must remain on the cart paths. No player may ride in a golf cart unless directed to do so by a Tournament official.
- 4. Spectators walking the course must remain 1/2 hole ahead or behind the tee group they are following.

Greens Fee: Participating schools will not be charged green fees for competition rounds of play. Call pro shop for practice rounds and fees.

Rules:

- A. The Rules of Golf, as approved by the United States Golf Association and R & A, for Stroke Play and OHSAA tournament regulations shall prevail for all tournaments sponsored by the OHSAA.
- B. The 2019 Rules of Golf included an optional Local Rule that allows players to drop a ball with 2 penalty strokes in an area near where the ball was lost or estimated to go out of bounds. The Local Rule is not one of the 24 Rules of Golf; it is an optional Local Rule. This 2-stroke optional Local Rule may NOT be used at the OHSAA Sectional, District, or State tournaments.
- C. OHSAA Local Rule Sectional Tournaments Only Maximum allowable score of 12 strokes shall be used during OHSAA tournament play at the sectional level. Should a player reach 12 strokes on a hole, the player shall stop play on that hole and record their score as a 12. A player's score who has used the 12-stroke limit may still contribute their score to a team / individual score.
