Entry fee will be \$25 per player. This includes greens fees and range balls the day of the tournament, a sandwich, chips and a drink. One cart will be provided for the coach of each team. The Northwest District is paying for this this year. Practice round greens fees of \$14 will not be paid by the NWDAB. Spectator carts will be permitted at a cost of \$25 per cart.

Once again this year spectators will be required to pay an entry fee of \$8 per person. This must be done online through Hometown ticketing. This money goes directly to the OHSAA. No tickets can be bought at the golf course, but tickets will be scanned at the course.

Because some schools will not have a full line up, tee times will not be assigned until all entries are received. Both nines will be used. First tee times at 9 am. Teams will be grouped together. Two coaches meetings will be held, one at 8:30 for the early starters and the other at 9:30 during which local rules for the day will be discussed.

Many of the pandemic rules in effect for last years tournament have been relaxed this year, but social distancing and mask wearing is still encouraged and players are asked to not congregate in large numbers in the clubhouse.

Some of the NWDAB rules specific all sectional tournaments are listed below.

Only one coach from each school may communicate with players during play and this is not permitted on the greens.

Each player is responsible to turn in an accurate signed scorecard for one other player in her group.

Players cannot use cell phones except in case of emergency. Range finder devices are permitted but to determine yardage only.

Lost balls and Out of Bounds will be penalized by stroke and distance only. Players are encouraged to play a provisional ball in those situations to speed up play.

The low three team and low three individuals not on those teams will advance to the district tournament. Ties for the third position will be broken by sudden death playoff.

In case of inclement weather, any decision to postpone the tournament will be made by 6 am the day of the event. Call Valley View at 4194681226 in case of questionable weather. Raindate is Friday October 1.
