 - f) Use Coaches | Golf | Submit Rosters to enter tournament.
 - i) Select golfers in playing order and click Submit Roster to submit!
 - ii) Click Get Printable Roster to print a copy for your records.
 - iii) Please submit tentative roster early! Submit changes online until the window closes.
- 3. Coaches may *check-in at arrival* on the 8th, beginning at <u>7:00 am</u>. I will ask that you check spellings of names and playing order. Scorecards will be given to you after all materials are in.
- 4. There will be a meeting prior to play at 7:30 AM for coaches and players to ensure that all participants are given the same instructions.

Tournament Rules

- 1. USGA rules will govern all play.
- 2. All puts must be holed out. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the tournament.
- 3. Make sure your golf balls have your own identifying mark.
- 4. On holes 5 & 13 if you hit your ball into the woods, you can choose from the following options:
 - A) If you can find the ball, you can play it as it lies.
 - B) If you cannot find the ball or it is unplayable, you can take a 1 stroke penalty and drop the ball on the line of flight where it <u>entered</u> the woods. On hole 13, you may also use the marked drop zone and take a one stroke penalty.
- 5. Out of bounds are marked by white stakes on holes 2, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 15, 17, & 18. Penalty; stroke & distant.
 - On hole number 8, any ball across the road is Out of Bounds. Any ball on the road may receive a free drop no closer to the hole.
 - On hole number 18, the white fence, behind the clubhouse, defines the Out of Bounds.
- 6. Chain link fence around the lagoons (holes 6, 11, 12, 13, 15) is out of bounds. If a player's ball is in bounds and is close to the fence they may get free relief, 1 club length, no closer to the hole.
- 7. In case of a possible lost ball, you should hit a provisional ball.
- 8. When hitting a provisional ball, make sure it is marked differently from the original ball and you identify the ball to your playing partners.
- 9. Distance markers in the middle of the fairway indicate distance to the middle of the green: Blue 200, White 150, Red 100. Also, there are 150 yard bushes on either side of the fairway. (Free drop if stance or swing is affected by 150 bushes)
- 10. Each scorecard is to be kept by an opponent. Each score must have 2 signatures on it (the person keeping the score and the player of that scorecard). Turn your card into your coach after it has been checked and signed.
