Division I Girls Sectional Tournament*

Format for Today

Today's format is an 18-hole individual stroke play event with four scores of the five counting towards qualifying for Districts. The USGA rules will govern play today and PipeStones local rules. Pace of play is very important, please make sure that each group plays at a pace of fifteen minutes per hole or 4 ½ hours for eighteen. Please make sure to rotate scorecards within your group and verify hole-by-hole scores after completion of play. Make sure each scorecard has two signatures and that each participant has an identifying mark on their golf ball.

Rules of the Day

1. The participants will play from the Green Tees.
2. All Play will be governed by the USGA rules of golf.
3. Out of Bounds is defined by White Stakes or Lines on #7, #8, #10 #13, #14, #15, #16 and #17.
4. Lateral Hazards are defined by Red Stakes or Lines on #2, #12, #13, #15, #16, #17 & #18
5. Yellow Stakes or Lines define water Hazards #3, #4, #5, #6, #7, #10, #11, #13, #16, #17 & #18.
6. Ground Under Repair is defined by White.
7. Play will begin off #1 & #10, please spend no more than five minutes on the turn and proceed to your back nine. .
8. The Scoring area will be located outside on the patio, if inclement weather the boards will be located in the clubhouse.
9. IF you are in doubt as to procedure or a rules situation, play out your original ball and a second ball taking relief. Record both scores and before signing your card, submit to the rules committee your situation.
10. The OHSAA coaching rule is in effect.
11. The OHSAA electronics rule is in effect.
12. Spectators may not talk to the players. They may, however, point out golf balls. A player will be disqualified for riding in a cart. Players may not have anyone caddy for them or pull a cart for them.
13. Any tobacco use by participants will result in disqualification.
14. **TWO STROKE PENALTY** for conduct unbecoming high school players. Such conduct shall include, but not be limited to: club throwing (releasing the club in a manner that could cause harm to any person on the course or damage the course), use of abusive language and willful acts to damage property or equipment on the course. Conduct deemed severe by the rules committee could result in disqualification.
15. Only the school coach may have a cart. No spectator carts.

Qualifying—4 teams and 4 individuals not on a qualifying team.

No awards at the sectional level. Playoffs will only be held for the final qualifying spots.
