**Awards:** We will award the top three placers in each weight class and score the top 4 in each weight class.

**Scoring:** 4 places

### **Saturday, February 19, 2022**

7:00 Sign-in at the head table

- A. Correct names on rosters and confirm seed nominations.
- B. Provide Alpha weigh-in sheets.
- C. All OHSAA Skin Authorizations appropriately signed/dated must be presented at check-in.

7:30 Weigh-in: All wrestlers shall be present and remain in the designated weigh-in area. The weigh-in shall proceed by weight classes beginning at 106 lbs. and end immediately upon completion of the 285 lbs. Class. A contestant may step on and off the first scale two times. If he/she fails to make weight on the first scale, he/she shall immediately step on each available scale one time in an attempt to make weight.

**If you anticipate a problem arriving by 8:00 AM, you must make arrangements prior to Friday to request an extension.** When your team arrives, all wrestlers must report to the weigh-in area immediately! Lighter weights will weigh-in immediately and upper weights will weigh-in with their weight class. Weigh-ins end after the 285 class is finished.

7:45 Seed Meeting: Seed nominations will be posted at [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com).

- A. We will seed the top four wrestlers in each class.
- B. Seeding nominees will be listed on the form based on the following criteria:
  - 1. 2021 State Place (8 places)
  - 2. 2021 District Place (top 6)
  - 3. 2021 Sectional Place (top 4)
  - 4. 2021 BVC Place (top 4)
  - 5. Current Varsity Record - No minimum.
- C. JH seeding will be based on 2021-22 record, 8-match minimum.
- D. Seeds will be determined in order from first to fourth by vote of coaches or concession of all (if 6 or less wrestlers, only **2** seeds). Pools will be drawn during the seed meeting, but will not be official until the conclusion of the meeting.
- E. **Format:** Two pools of four if 7 or 8; full round robin if 6 wrestlers or less. Placements in the two pools of four will be determined by criteria, followed by the placement matches. Places in the round robin will be determined by criteria.
- F. Scoring 4 places

9:00 First of Three Rounds of Pools (2-3-3.5-4)

First round of Round Robins (if 6 or less wrestlers) (2-3-3.5-4)

High school and junior high matches to be wrestled concurrently.

Byes will be awarded 3 points

Finals app. 45 minutes after last preliminary round

- 1. Introduction of finalists followed by national anthem.
- 2. All matches to be wrestled concurrently with junior high finals.
- 3. Awards will be presented by the coach of weight class champion after 285.

Online Instructions

Entry window opens: **8:00 AM, Sunday, February 6**

Closes precisely: **5:00 PM, Thursday, February 17<sup>th</sup>.**

**Submit your intended roster early! Return anytime before the deadline to make changes!**

1. **Entries must be submitted using the Online Entry Form at [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com)!**
  - a) Create your account early and enter your master alphabetic roster.
2. **You will need an account to submit data using BaumsPage.** Go to [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com) and use **Online Entries** or **Login** to access your account
  - a) Click the **Help** link and print **Online Entry Instructions for Wrestling** if you need detailed instructions.
  - b) **If you did not have an account last year, use Apply here** to create your account.
    - i) **Please note: Passwords are case-sensitive!**
    - ii) If you don't know your password, click the **Forget your password?** link to have a temporary password e-mailed to you.
    - iii) Complete the requested information | Check the "I'm not a robot." box | Submit Application
  - c) If you had an account last year, you can login using that e-mail address and password.
  - d) Use **Coaches | Select Teams** to select your **School** and **Sport**.
  - e) Use **Coaches | Wrestling | Modify Athletes** to enter alphabetic roster, using proper case.
  - f) Use **Coaches | Wrestling | Submit Rosters** to enter tournament.
    - i) Select wrestlers in their weight and click **Submit Roster** to submit!
    - ii) For each weight class, click on **None** and select the athlete from the drop-down list.
    - iii) If appropriate, enter seeding information as requested. Leave blank if not up for seed!
    - iv) Click **Get Printable Roster** to print a copy for your records.
    - v) Please submit tentative roster early! **Submit changes online** until the window closes.
    - vi) **No extras.**
    - vii) Coaches may make changes to your line-up when you check-in Saturday morning!
3. **Event Rosters can only be submitted or corrected while the "Entry Window" is open!**
  - a) The window closes automatically **precisely at the time and date** listed.
  - b) **Submit Rosters** early and return to make changes **anytime before** the window closes.
  - c) Entries **cannot** be edited or submitted online **after the window closes**.
4. Barring unforeseen difficulties, rosters, seed nominations and the entry grid will be posted by 9:00 PM on the 17<sup>th</sup>.
5. **If there are any problems with the Online Form**, click the **Contact Us** link and submit a **Help Request**.
  - a) **Please allow up to 8 hours for a response! \*Most responses will be in less than 4 hours.**
