TIME: Wrestling will begin at 9:00am

WEIGH-INS:

Weigh-ins will be conducted at your school before you leave for the tournament.

Coaches, please report to the head table upon arrival to turn in your weigh in sheets and confirm your team entry. Any scratches will be done at this time. If you have any female wrestlers on your team, please advise us in advance so we can plan for locker rooms. Please drop off your wrestlers at the front entrance of the High School. (Do Not use the side door nearest the football field. Ask your bus drivers to park in front of the High School in the main parking lot. **PLEASE TRY TO ARRIVE NO LATER THAN 7:45 AM, SO WE CAN ENSURE TO START ON TIME.**

TEAM ENTRY:

Please submit your lineup on or before 7:00pm Thursday, December 11, 2024 on Baumspage.com. THIS WILL BE YOUR OFFICIAL ENTRY FOR YOUR WRESTLERS. Please enter your lineup as soon as possible so we can notify coaches on Friday if any extra wrestlers get entered in the tournament. **Please provide us with an e-mail and good contact number to be reached in case we need clarification.**

FORMAT:

The Madison MS Invitational is a round robin style tournament with the goal of getting wrestlers as many matches as possible. This format will include the following:

1. Weight classes will be wrestled in either a round robin format or a pool/bracket format.
2. Weight classes with an odd number of wrestlers will be evened out with an "Extra" wrestler (Madison will have first choice to add an "Extra" wrestler).
3. We will run up to five rounds plus the finals. We will wrestle for the top six places but will stay within the six-match limit.
 - a. All matches in a Round Robin Pool will be (3) three 1:30 periods until the finals. Third and Fifth place matches will be 1-1:30-1:30. If a wrestler is in a consolation bracket, these will also be 1-1:30-1:30 periods.
4. Team points will be determined by dual meet scoring criteria.
 - a. There will **NOT** be any advancement points.
 - b. Byes will be scored after a win in the pool.
 - c. Placement points will be based on 6 placements.

AWARDS: Top 4 Individuals will receive a medal (We **WILL** wrestle the 5th/6th place bouts).
Top 2 Teams will receive an award

SEEDING:

1. OAC JH State Placer
2. OAC JH State Qualifier
3. OAC JH District Placer
4. OAC GS State Placer
5. Last Year W-L Record (Min. 10 matches, +.500)

SPECTATORS: All spectators enter the building through the front of the High School. There will be room available in the cafeteria for team food and team items. There will be no electrical service. Please leave the area as you found it. **Parents and Spectators will NOT be allowed to enter the building until 8:15am when the admissions gate arrives.** Please make sure your parents do not enter before then.

No smoking is allowed on the school grounds.

SPORTS MED: Our Team trainer will be at the tournament all day. The Madison EMS will be notified and on call.
