1. **ONLINE ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS:** Please follow the enclosed instructions for entering your wrestlers online. It is important that you are aware of the online entry start and end deadline.

**Online Entry will open on Friday, December 10<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 AM**

**Online Entry will close on Thursday, December 15<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 PM**

The seed nominations based on the stated seeding criteria will be posted on Baumspage by 9:00 PM, Thursday, December 15<sup>th</sup>. Any challenges to the posted seeds should be e-mailed to Tournament Director Rick Twining ([ricktwining@gmail.com](mailto:ricktwining@gmail.com)) by 10 a.m. Friday, December 16<sup>th</sup>. The final seed nomination list will be updated and posted again by 1:00 PM on Friday, December 17<sup>th</sup>.

**ALL CHANGES MUST BE MADE BY NO LATER THAN 6:30 PM FRIDAY NIGHT. AFTER THIS TIME, IF A WRESTLER CHANGES WEIGHT CLASS, THERE IS NO GUARANTEE THAT THERE WILL BE SLOT AVAILABLE. A SCORING WRESTLER CHANGING WEIGHT CLASSES WILL NOT BUMP A NON-SCORING WRESTLER. WE WILL ACCEPT EXTRAS TO FILL WEIGHT CLASSES TO 6, 8, 10, 12 OR 16 PER WT.**

2. **SEEDING CRITERIA:** The seeding criteria based on last year's season statistics are as follows: Last year's OAC Jr High State Placer, OAC Jr High District Placer top 6, last season's record (10 match minimum), and this season's record (six match minimum) will be last. Placement in the pool for non-seeded wrestlers will be randomly computer generated.
3. **WEIGH-INS:** will be held at your home school before departing Saturday morning. Rick Twining will email weigh sheets of your submitted rosters to be used for your Saturday morning weigh-in **ALL COACHES MUST EMAIL/TEXT A PHOTO OF THEIR WEIGH SHEET NO LATER THAN 8:00 TO [ricktwining@gmail.com](mailto:ricktwining@gmail.com)** (440-724-1404). Hair, nails and skin will be checked upon arrival. Please arrive at Monroeville High School no later than 9:00. Please note the copy of the new weigh-in procedure on attached page. Wrestling will start at 10:00 A.M. with finals beginning as soon as possible after bracket semifinals. There will be a coach's meeting before the finals to go over finals match-ups, MVW considerations, and other pertinent information.
7. **A TROPHY:** will be presented to the championship team and runner-up team. A plaque will go to the most valuable wrestler, to be voted on by the coaches. Medals will be presented to the top 4 in each weight class.
8. **ENTRY FEE:** The entry fee must be paid at the coaches meeting on Saturday if it has not already been paid.

## WEIGH-INS

1. If a contestant fails to make weight on one of the designated scales, he/she can immediately step off and back on that scale, one time. They are also allowed to step on any other scale in that room, one time. They are not allowed to wait and try after the 245 lb. class. If a scoring wrestler does not make weight, the extra wrestler can be entered as a scoring wrestler.
2. Once weigh-ins start, all weight loss or gain must stop by all contestants whether they are in the gym or the locker room.
3. Reminder – home weigh-ins be completed by 8:00 AM, and a photo of your weigh sheet emailed to [ricktwining@gmail.com](mailto:ricktwining@gmail.com). DON'T BE LATE. Please be at the school by 9:00 A.M.

4. Reminder- Competitors must weigh-in wearing a legal uniform **with suitable undergarment(s)** worn underneath per NFHS Rule 4-5-7E.

**PLEASE NOTE: This year we will run the tournament with a pool-to-bracket format that will maximize the number of matches for each weight class. Each weight will wrestle for 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 5th place and team score will be kept by using 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place scoring. Awards will only be given to 1st place through 4th place; however, the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> place finishers should show up at the award podium for introduction.**
