**RE: MIDDLE SCHOOL WRESTLING TOURNAMENT
NEW LEXINGTON HIGH SCHOOL – FEBRUARY 1, 2025 – 10:00 AM**

The New Lexington Athletic Department is pleased that you have chosen to participate in our middle school tournament featuring 28 teams. This year's tournament will be an Olympic pool format on six mats held at the New Lexington High School. Below you will find information that you may find helpful in preparing yourself and your team to participate.

Due to the growth of the tournament and to eliminate the possibility of exceeding the six match per day limit, we must limit the entries to 20 per weight class. It is imperative that you submit as much information as possible for all your starting wrestlers as this information will be used to determine who will get a spot in the regular tournament and who will be bumped into the "extras" pool(s). Regardless, all extra wrestlers who are placed into the extras pool(s) are guaranteed two matches. **20 wrestlers are included in the base entry fee. Additional wrestlers will be \$40 each.**

ROSTERS and SEEDING: Rosters and seed nominations will be handled on baumspage again this year. The deadline to submit your roster and seed nominations is **6:00 PM, Friday, January 31**. If you need help submitting your roster, contact Terry Young at terry@baumspage.com or 740-517-0195. Seed nominations will be posted on baumspage by 6:30 PM on Friday, January 31. Final pools will be drawn at the conclusion of weigh-ins. Seeding will be based strictly on criteria: 2024 OAC junior high state (top 8); 2024 OAC junior high district (top 6); current year record (10 match and greater than 50% win minimum).

TEAM CHECK-IN AND SKIN CHECKS: Teams should plan to arrive no later than 7:45 AM on Saturday.

COACHES MEETING: Coaches meeting will be at approximately 9:15 AM on Saturday to review pools and to discuss the flow of the tournament. All seeding will be done based strictly on criteria, so it is imperative that the information you submit online is accurate. Be sure to review the confirmation page after you submit your roster.

ADMISSION: Adults - \$10.00, Students \$5.00. Gates open at 8:00 AM.

PARKING: Bus drivers should drop off the team at the school and park in the middle school parking lot. Overflow parking is also available at the middle school. A shuttle bus will be available to transport bus drivers and fans who park in the middle school parking lot to the high school and back throughout the day.

COACHES PASSES: One wrestler will be allowed one coach; two to four wrestlers will be allowed two coaches; five or more wrestlers will be allowed five coaches.
