GATE ADMISSION: \$10.00 Adults \$5.00 Students

BUS PARKING: Drop off at OHS and park across Mineral Springs St in Elementary Parking Lot

LOCKER ROOMS: Available for changing, but locker storage will not be provided.

ENTRY FEE: \$250.00. Please bring it to coaches meeting if it hasn't already been paid. Make checks payable to ORRVILLE HIGH SCHOOL

CONCESSIONS: A full concession stand will be available. NO CROCKPOTS permitted due to power and space issues. A well-stocked hospitality room will be provided for coaches.

AWARDS: The top 4 placers in each weight class will receive medals. The 1st place team will be awarded a medal for each team member.

FORMAT: Pool to Bracket Format (Formats will vary based on number of entrants to maximize bouts for each wrestler). Tournament will run on 4-5 mats.

BAUM'S PAGE ENTRY INFO:

Web site: Use the [Online Entry Form](http://www.baumspage.com) posted at www.baumspage.com to submit rosters before **11:59 PM, Sunday, January 16th**. We are going to do a "blind draw" prior to your arrival. We are not going to be seeding wrestlers. (If you do have an exceptional wrestler at a particular weight class please note this with your entry and we will put them in opposite pools. You may enter extras on Baum's Page roster and we will do our best to get them in the tourney. Since bracket sheets will be done when you arrive at the tournament, it is essential that you put kids in a weight class that you are confident that they will make. Roster changes may be allowed at the director's discretion, but are not guaranteed.

Entering Rosters:

1. All accounts from 2022-23 were retained, but associations with schools and sports were cleared. If you had an account last year, use that e-mail address and password to login
2. If you did not have an account, click on Online Entries and Apply here! Fill-in the form, check the checkbox or "I'm not a robot" and Submit
3. If you need help, use the Contact Us link. In an emergency call 513-594-6154 or 740-517-0195!
4. Submit an "intended" roster early! Return any time before the deadline to make changes!
 - a) Use **Coaches | Select Teams** to select your school and team.
 - i) Select **School Type** | highlight school | **Get Available School Teams | Select Sport | Make me the Coach**
 - b) Use **Coaches | Wrestling | Modify Athletes** to enter your athlete's names and grades into the database. You may enter them one at a time or paste a complete roster from Excel.
 - c) Use **Coaches | Wrestling | Submit Rosters** to enter wrestlers into their weight classes.
 - i) Below the Varsity roster, please list potential JVs that may be able to fill open weights. Please prioritize your JV wrestler list!
 - ii) Only JVs submitted online will be allowed to weigh-in and be allowed to fill open weights after weigh-ins are finished.
 - d) Click Save and Submit Rosters to submit your tournament entry form.
 - e) Click Printable Roster and Confirmation Form to print a copy for your records.

Additional comments and Notes:

1. We are scoring the round robin rounds using tournament scoring with the range of points from 2 to 4 points. A bye will receive 2 points if a wrestler wins a match in his pool
2. Extra JVs will be permitted to weigh-in and fill open weights. Final assignments will be determined after weigh-ins are finished!
