Miami East is pleased to host the Three Rivers Conference Wrestling Tournament for both Junior High and High School. A round robin format will be used. Tournament scoring will be used with the range of points being from 2 to 4 points. Bye points will be awarded provided a wrestler wins a match. The final round will match up the top two seeds.

Doors will open for teams at 7:00 a.m. Teams should check-in, confirm rosters, and check weight prior to 7:50 a.m. Weigh-ins will be by teams and will begin at 8:00 a.m. and end at 8:45 a.m. The order of weigh-ins will be based on order of check-in. There will be a coaches meeting at **9:30 a.m.** in the school lecture hall.

The first round of wrestling will begin at **10:00 a.m.** with the High School. The second round will be the first round of the Junior High Tournament. We will continue to alternate rounds for the remainder of the day. Short breaks for time may have to be used and we will take a break for lunch.

Following the final 285 pound match, medals will be presented to the top 3 wrestlers in each weight class. Medal winners are asked to stay in uniform for the awards presentations.

Only those wrestlers who are competing will be admitted without a pass. Additional admittance will be based on the number of competitors. Teams with one to six competitors will receive five passes, teams with seven to ten wrestlers will receive six passes and teams with eleven to fourteen wrestlers will receive seven passes. These passes are for coaches and support personnel. Remember to use your TRC passes.

Doors will open at **9:00 a.m.** for the general public. Admission to the tournament will be \$10.00 for adults and \$7.00 for Senior Citizens and students.

Locker rooms and lockers will be assigned for each team. Teams will be permitted to carry in food provided that it is not eaten in the gym. Concessions will be available.

1. **Seeding:** Seeding will be by criteria only. We will seed each weight class using last season's State, District, and Sectional places plus winning record.

1. *All accounts from 2024-25 were retained*, but the associations with schools and sports were cleared. If you had an account last year, use that e-mail address and password to log-in
2. If you did not have an account, click on **Online Entries** and **Apply Here!** Fill-in the form, check the checkbox or "I'm not a robot" and **Submit**

4. **Submit an "intended" roster early! Return any time before deadline to make changes!**
 - a. Use **Coaches | Select Teams** to select your school and team.
 - i. Select **School Type | highlight school | Get Available School Teams | Select Sport | Make me the Coach**
 - b. Use **Coaches | Wrestling | Modify Athletes** to enter your athlete's names and grades into the database. You may enter them one at a time or paste a complete roster from Excel.
 - c. Use **Coaches | Wrestling | Submit Rosters** to enter wrestlers into their weight classes. Enter appropriate seed information for seed able wrestlers.
 - d. Click **Save and Submit Rosters** to submit your tournament entry form.
 - e. Click **Printable Roster and Confirmation Form** to print a copy for your records.
5. You may make changes to your line-up when you check-in Saturday morning!
6. Barring unforeseen difficulties, seed nominations and the entry grid will be posted by 2:00 p.m. after the window closes.

Awards: Top 3 placers in each weight class will receive a medal

Food: Food will be provided for officials and coaches only during the day. Please have Wrestlers eat in the cafeteria area. **NO FOOD** or **DRINKS** in the Gym.

Lockers: Lockers will be provided for the wrestlers. Please lock all valuables! The school is **NOT** responsible for lost or stolen items.

Additional comments and notes:

1. We are scoring the round robin rounds using tournament scoring with the range of points from 2 to 4 points. A bye will receive 2 points if a wrestler wins a match
2. The final round will match up the 5th and 6th seeds, 3rd and 4th seeds and the top two seeds.
