

# Watkins Girls Wrestling Tournament - December 2025

**Contract** To enter wrestlers into the tournament a team must have been invited by Eddie Jayne, Brad Syfers or Jake Perkins, and sent a contract through DragonFly.

**Crockpots** Not permitted

**Eligibility** For the middle school tournament wrestlers must be in 7th or 8th grade. No 6th graders.  
For the high school tournament wrestlers must be in 9th - 12th grade. No 8th graders.

**Entrance** Enter the building at the front entrance near the flagpole. Door 1.

**Extra Pound** If your team is competing the day before the tournament contact Eddie Jayne as soon as possible so all teams can be notified about an extra pound allowance at weigh ins.

**Finals** The placement matches will be showcased.

First, third, fifth, and seventh place matches for each weight class will occur at the same time.  
When all matches have finished the next weight class will begin at the same time.

**Format** M.S. - Four mats in the main gym. One mat in the auxiliary gym.  
H.S. - Four mats in the main gym. Two mats in the auxiliary gym.  
Pools to brackets.  
Baumspage.com will have tournament brackets and information.

**Full Weight** For high school, weight classes will be capped at 20 wrestlers. The seeding/selection criteria will be used to select the top 20 wrestlers if there are over 20 entries in a weight class.  
The top 3 teams from 2024 are guaranteed one entry per weight class.  
1. Harrison 2. Sandusky 3. Gahanna Lincoln  
The host school, Watkins Memorial, is guaranteed one entry per weight class.

**Hospitality Room** Will be available for coaches with a wristband in room A300.

M.S. 1-16 wrestlers = 2 coach's wristbands      17+ wrestlers = 3 coach's wristbands  
H.S. 1-14 wrestlers = 2 coach's wristbands      15+ wrestlers = 3 coach's wristbands

**Parking** Cars must park on the blacktop. Cars parked in the grass will be towed.

## **Seeding**

### **High School Seeding/Selection Criteria:**

1. Previous Season, HS State Placer, Top 8
2. Previous Season, HS District Placer, Top 6
3. Previous Season, OAC MS State Placer, Top 6
4. Previous Season, Watkins HS Tournament Placer, Top 5
5. Current Season Record, 5 match minimum, 50% or above win percentage
6. Current Season Record, 3 match minimum, No minimum win percentage

The seeding/selection criteria will be used to select the top 20 wrestlers if there are over 20 entries in a weight class.

Seeds will be on Baumspage by Friday evening.

Coaches have until 11:00 pm Friday to challenge a seed based on a head to head win from this season.

### **Middle School Seeding Criteria:**

1. Previous Season, OAC MS State Placer, Top 6
2. Previous Season, OHWAY MS State Placer, Top 6
3. Previous Season, Watkins MS Tournament Placer, Top 5
4. Current Season Record, 4 match minimum, 50% or above win percentage

**Team Admission** All wrestlers, 3 coaches, 2 stats, and 1 bus driver will be admitted free of charge.

**Team Entry Fee** Mail to: Watkins Memorial High School, 1954 Warrior Way, Pataskala, OH 43062  
Make checks out to SWL.

**Tie Breaker Criteria** If there is a three way tie at the end of pool wrestling with all three wrestlers having the same record, the wrestler with the higher ranking will be determined starting with tie breaker criteria number 3. Then, the remaining two wrestlers will be ranked based on who won the head to head match.

**Tie Breaker Criteria**

The winner shall be the wrestler who:

1. Won the greater number of matches.
2. Won the head to head match.
3. Has been penalized the least number of team points for flagrant or unsportsmanlike conduct.
4. Accumulated the greater number of team points for all matches.
5. Accumulated the greater number of team points for pins, defaults, forfeits, or disqualifications.
6. Accumulated the greater number of team points for technical falls.
7. Accumulated the greater number of team points for major decisions.
8. Accumulated the greater number of team points for decisions.
9. Accumulated the greater number of pins in the least time.
10. Accumulated the quickest pin.
11. Accumulated the greatest total point differential for decisions.
12. If none of the above resolves the tie, a flip of a coin will be used.

**Trainer** Wrestlers that want the Watkins athletic trainer to tape them must have a note from their home school's trainer.

**Weight Change** No weight class changes after the Baum's Page registration ends.

**Weigh Ins** Morning of the tournament at Watkins Memorial High School in the auxiliary gym.

## Online Entry Instructions - Wrestling

Please use the **Online Entry Form** at [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com) to submit by entries before the entry deadline.

**The entry window will close precisely at the time listed in your information!  
Submit your "intended" roster early! Return anytime before the deadline to make changes!**

- Entries must be submitted using the Online Entry Form at [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com)!**
- You will need an account to submit data using Baums Page Online Entry System!**
  - If you already have an account**, login and use **Coaches | Select Teams** to claim your school and team.
    - If you forgot your **Password**, click the **Forget your password** link on the **Login** page to request a new one.
    - Multiple sports, levels, and genders can all be included on one account!
  - If you are a "first time" user, please create your account early!** \*See #2 below!
    - If there is a problem creating an account, you may need to temporarily disable a "firewall", change the Internet security setting in your web browser, or try a different computer!
    - If your school is not included in the list of schools or someone else is already "associated" with your school and team, click the **Help** link and submit a request. Allow 24 hours for a response!
- The actual data entry is a multi-step process:**
  - Use **Coaches | Select Teams** to select your school and sport.
    - Find your school in the dropdown list and highlight it
    - Click **Get Available School Teams / Sports** | then **Select Sport** | click **Make me the coach**
    - Repeat if coaching both HS and MS.
  - Use **Coaches | Wrestling | Modify Athletes** to enter your athlete's names and grades into the database.
    - You may enter them one at a time or paste your complete roster from an Excel file.
    - To paste from Excel use three fields - **first name**, **last name**, and **grade**.
  - Use **Coaches | Wrestling | Submit Rosters** to enter wrestlers and their seed information into weight classes.
    - Click **Submit Rosters** to submit your tournament entry form and **Get Printable Roster** to print a copy for your records.
- Data will be stored** so it may be edited and submitted for other tournaments that use **Baums Page** for entries!

### To enter roster online:

- Go to [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com), follow links to **Wrestling**, the specific tournament, and the [Online Entry Form](#).
  - Or click [Online Entry](#) or [Login](#) at the top of **Baum's Page**
  - Make sure entries are submitted before the posted entry deadline.

2. **If you do not have an account**, click on [Apply](#).
  1. Enter the **Account Holder's Name**, an active **E-mail Address**, and a **Password**.
    1. Use either the coach's e-mail address or the coach's designee!
    2. If you do not have an e-mail account, use the e-mail address of a friend or someone who will give you messages that are sent to the e-mail address.
    3. **Enter E-mail address and Password twice!** \*Write them down and use for all future logins
  2. Enter your **Work, Home**, and **Cell** phones. \*If unlisted, enter unlisted or none.
  3. Check the "**I'm not a robot**" box.
  4. Click **Submit** application
  
3. **If you have an account**, click on [Login](#) and enter your **UserID** and **Password!**
  1. Use **Coaches | Select Teams** to claim your school and team.
    1. Click **Get Available School Teams** | click **Select Sport** in the dropdown below | highlight your sport | then click **Make me the Coach**
    2. If you coach both HS and MS, add each level separately.
    3. If **Association already exists for a user**, click the [Contact Us](#) link and submit a request.
  
  2. Use **Coaches | Wrestling | {select your team} | Modify Athletes** to enter your **roster!**  
\*Return at your convenience to edit it.
    1. Type all names in upper and lower case. \*Please check all entries carefully!
    2. Check the **Girl Athlete** box for all girls | then **Save Athlete Changes**.
  
  3. Use **Coaches | Wrestling | {select your team} | Submit Rosters** to submit entries for the tournament..
    1. Select the **correct tournament** from the **Event** "drop-down" menu.
      - a. For each weight class entered, click on **Select a Wrestler...** and select the athletes from the drop-down list.
      - b. If appropriate, enter seeding information as requested. Leave blank if not up for a seed!
      - c. Click **Submit Roster**, then click **Get Printable Roster** to print a copy for your records. **What you see is what will be processed!**
    2. If there are errors or an athlete is missing, use [Modify Athletes](#) to make the correction and use [Submit Rosters](#) to submit entries again.
  
4. **Event Rosters for a meet can only be submitted or corrected while the "Entry Window" is open!**
  1. **Submit Event Rosters** early and return to make changes **anytime before** the window closes.
    1. The window closes automatically **precisely at the time and date** listed!
    2. Entries **cannot** be edited or **submitted online after the window closes!**
