

Beachwood DIII Sectional Wrestling Tournament - Schedule

Submit the following forms to Ryan Peters, Beachwood H.S. Athletic Director via e-mail by Friday, 2/7:

- Weight Certification Alpha Master Report (of all participants)
- Eligibility Certificate (listing all participants)
- Sectional Wrestling Pass list (see attachment)
- 2014 OHSAA Tournament Entry form (listing all participants and certified coaches)

Registration: Entry of your team's lineup must be done online, via <http://www.baumspage.com>, no later than 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 12.

Session One (Friday, February 14):

- Facility opens at 3:00 p.m. for teams to arrive, scales open at 3:15 for wrestlers to check weight
- **Weigh-ins** will begin at **4:00**, and conducted in alphabetical order by school
- **Coaches meeting** for bracketing and going over key tournament operations items will commence **15 minutes after the completion of weigh-ins** in the hospitality room
- Doors open for fan admission at 5:00, with **wrestling beginning at 6:00**. Rounds to be wrestled will be **championship first round** (weights with 9 or more wrestlers) and **championship quarterfinal round**. With 12 teams in field, the consolation first round does not exist.
- Projected end time is 8:00 p.m.
- Weigh-outs will begin at 7:00 p.m. Wrestlers may weigh out after their weight class is done for the evening. Weigh-outs will end 30 minutes after the last match is completed.

Session Two (Saturday, February 15):

- Any wrestler that did not weigh-out on Friday, will be able to weigh-in at 10:00 a.m.
- Otherwise, doors open for admission starting at 11:00, with **wrestling to begin at 12:00 p.m.** The **second round of consolation** (weights with 9 or more wrestlers) will be the initial round; with the next round a *joint round of championship semifinals* (2 mats) and **consolation quarterfinals** (1 mat, moving to all 3 mats as available); and followed by the **consolation semifinals** on all three mats.
- Projected end time is 3:00 p.m., and all wrestlers, coaches, and fans will be asked to clear the gymnasium

Session Three (Saturday, February 15):

- Doors will open for admission of fans, wrestlers, and coaches starting at 5:00 p.m.
- Wrestlers competing for first through sixth place should be back at Beachwood H.S. by 5:30 for the Parade of Champions
- The Parade of Champions and associated introductions will begin at 5:50, with **wrestling slated to begin at 6:00**.
- The **first place, third place, and fifth place** matches will be wrestled one weight class at a time on three mats
- All awards will be given after the completion of the last weight class (285 pounds), and those wrestlers finishing first through sixth will be recognized on the awards stand
