Penalty for falsification of records will result in automatic disqualification of the wrestler from the tournament and/or a written notice of the coach to his school's principal, school board, the Northeast Ohio District Athletic Board [NEDAB], and the Ohio High School Athletic Association. Bring all records submitted to the seed meeting in case there are any questions.

**AWARDS:** No team trophy will be presented to the Sectional Team Champions (OHSAA directive). The individual champion in each of the fourteen (14) weight classes will be presented with the OHSAA bracket sheet.

**PHYSICIAN/ATHLETIC TRAINERS:** There will be a physician in attendance at all sessions; if the physician is not available, certified athletic trainers will be available to meet your medical needs. When injury time is being used, a coach and/or official can request the presence of the physician. The physician can check any injured wrestler if he deems it necessary for the health and well-being of that wrestler. NOTE: ALL decisions made by the tournament physician(s) are FINAL.

**ADMISSION COSTS:** \$10.00 for adult (All Day) \$6.00 for students/senior citizen (All Day)  
\$6.00 for adult (Finals), \$4.00 (Finals) for students/senior citizen at the gate

Only all day passes and finals tickets will be offered. First session tickets are not an option (this will save clearing the gym before finals).

These prices are set by the Northeast District Board. There are no presale tickets.

**PASSES:** The Northeast District Athletic Board has instituted a form for all teams to serve as a pass list. This list includes: ONLY 14 wrestlers, Head Coach, THREE Assistant Coaches, 2 Scorekeepers, Bus Driver, Superintendent and Guest, Principal and Guest, and Athletic Director and Guest will be admitted.

**All other coaches, wrestlers and staff not on pass list will have to pay to gain admittance to the tournament.**

**TOURNAMENT PROGRAMS and BRACKETS:** Programs will be available for \$2.00 each.

Updates of results will also be available for \$ 1.00.

**CONCESSIONS:** The Band Boosters of Wadsworth H.S. will have the concession stand open throughout the tournament.

**HOSPITALITY ROOM:** The Wadsworth wrestling moms will have the Hospitality room set up on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor in the Senior Commons until the finals.

**BRINGING IN FOOD** – Teams can bring in their own food and use our cafeteria tables, but NO ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES can be used in our cafeteria per health and safety codes.

**T-SHIRTS:** T-shirts, sponsored by the OHSAA, will be available for purchase throughout the tournament.

**LOCKER ROOMS: LOCK IT UP!** We will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

**QUALIFIERS TO THE NORTH CANTON HOOVER DISTRICT:** The top four (4) place finishers in each weight class from the Wadsworth Sectional will qualify for the North Canton Hoover District, to be held Friday and Saturday, March 1,2, 2019. Coaches need to make sure all wrestlers that qualify for the district tournament check their records, information (name spelling, grade, etc.) before the Finals.

**SKIN CHECK LETTER:** If your wrestler has a questionable skin condition, the official OHSAA Skin Condition Form must be filled out and accompany the wrestler through weigh-ins. This should be dated NO EARLIER than one week before the Sectional Tournament.

7:30 AM **Weigh-in:** All wrestlers shall be present and remain in the designated weigh-in area.

All OHSAA Skin Authorization forms must be presented at weigh-in.

**The weigh-in shall proceed by weight class, 106-285**

A contestant may step on and off the first scale two times. If he fails to make weight on the first scale, he shall immediately step on each available scale one time in an attempt to make weight.
