Wrestling Schedule:

Wrestling will start at 10:00am on Saturday 2/24/24 and we will wrestle straight through until finals. Finals will start approximately one hour after the last consolation match. All other breaks will only be taken as a necessity to allow the minimum required rest for the wrestlers

Seeding Meeting: Saturday 2/24, immediately after weigh-ins are complete. Penalty for falsification of records will result in automatic disqualification of the wrestler from the tournament and/or a written notice of the coach to his school's principal, school board, the Northeast Ohio District Athletic Board [NEDAB], and the Ohio High School Athletic Association. Bring all records submitted to the seed meeting in case there are any questions.

Weigh-ins

- All wrestlers should be ready to weigh in and have their skin checked as their weight class is called to the weigh in area.
- All OHSAA skin authorizations appropriately signed and dated must be presented along with any special equipment or braces.
- The weigh-in shall proceed through weight classes beginning at 106 lbs and end immediately upon completion of the 285 lb class.
- A contestant that fails to make weight on their designated scale will have the opportunity to immediately step on each available scale in attempt to make weight.

Wrestling:

Wrestlers will be need to report to their specific mat as their match approaches. On deck wrestlers should report to their scorers table prior to the start of their match to check in. Wrestlers should be ready to wrestle (warm-ups off and headgear on) as the match before theirs is completed. Only two team personnel will be permitted mat side during their wrestlers match.

Passes: Up to fourteen (14) Sectional wrestlers will be admitted to the wrestling tournament. Additionally, one head coach (1) and four additional passes. All extra personnel (i.e., statisticians, trainers, managers, etc) are required to purchase a ticket at the regular admission price. School administrators (superintendents, principals, and athletic administrators), will be issued generic tickets from HOMETOWN Ticketing through the OHSAA.

Concession Stand:

The concession stand will be open at 9:00 on Saturday. There will be many healthy items for your wrestlers to purchase after weigh-ins.

Media:

Requests for media credentials shall be directed to the tournament manager. Proper credentials must be presented for admission at the pass gate.

Hospitality Room:

This room only for tournament workers, officials, and coaches and will be run by our wrestling parents who are volunteering their time.

Locker rooms, Bags, Coolers:

Locker rooms will be available. Wrestlers are asked to store their bags in the lockers provided. Large crowds are expected for each session, using the locker rooms will ensure an ample amount of seating. Coolers will not be permitted in the gymnasium and can be stored in our cafeteria.

Physician/Athletic Trainers: There will be a physician in attendance at all sessions; if the physician is not available, certified athletic trainers will be available to meet your medical needs. When injury time is being used, a coach and/or official can request the presence of the physician. The physician can check any injured wrestler if he deems it necessary for the health and well-being of that wrestler. NOTE: ALL decisions made by the tournament physician(s) are FINAL.

Finals & Awards

Weight class awards will be presented throughout the finals. Per OHSAA the weight class winner will receive the sectional bracket sheet and no other individual or team awards will be given.

Top 4 placers in each weight class will qualify for the 2024 OHSAA Division I District Wrestling Championships, Friday, March 1st through Saturday, March 2nd at Perrysburg HS. The 5th place finisher will serve as the alternate if one of the top four are unable to compete. Coaches need to make sure all wrestlers that qualify for the district tournament have correct records, and information (name spelling, grade, etc.) before the Finals.
