Finals – Will begin 30 min after Preliminary Round Approx. 3:00 PM

WEIGH-INS: Saturday, February 29th promptly at 8:00 AM - BY WEIGHT CLASS

SEEDING: Saturday, February 29th approx. 8:30 AM Bracket Clarification Meeting for Coaches Meeting (Room 134).

ADMISSION: Each Session:
\$5.00 for STUDENTS (or \$7 both sessions)
\$7.00 for ADULTS (or \$10 both sessions)

PARKING: All buses should pull up to the gym entrance doors, drop off coaches & wrestlers, drive forward along the front of the building, and park in the Lot at the South end of the high school.

****Vehicles Parked in a Fire Lane will be ticketed****

COACHES:

Weight class entries must be submitted by Thursday, February 27th at 7:00 PM. Wrestlers are “locked” in their weight classes at that time and cannot be entered in another weight class. Schools will be subject to a \$50 fine for wrestlers entered after the deadline.

No late substitutions will be accepted after weigh-ins begin except:

- a. Academic or disciplinary ineligibility.
- b. Family matters that necessitate a wrestler being withdrawn.
- c. A medical emergency or illness experienced by the wrestler.
- d. Failure to make weight or pass skin check.

Each team is responsible for submitting their own rosters and wrestlers seeding credentials using the online entry system found on [baumspage](#). If you have not used [baumspage](#) this year, click on *ONLINE ENTRY SYSTEM*, and apply for an account immediately.

Coaches must provide the **Weight Certification Alpha Master Report** listing all participants prior to the seeding meeting. Coaches should be prepared to provide the weigh-in sheet from **each participants scratch weigh-in** event.

FOOD:

The Bee Athletic Boosters will provide concessions throughout the Sectional Tournament.

PASSES:

The Northeast District Athletic Board has instituted a form for all teams to serve as a pass list. This list includes: ONLY 14 wrestlers, Head Coach, THREE Assistant Coaches, Student Manager, Scorekeeper, Bus Driver, Superintendent and Guest, Principal and Guest, and Athletic Director and Guest will be admitted. **ALL OTHER COACHES, WRESTLERS AND STAFF NOT ON PASS LIST WILL HAVE TO PAY TO GAIN ADMITTANCE TO THE TOURNAMENT.**

SECTIONAL WRESTLING SEEDING CRITERIA – 2020

2020 OHSAA Wrestling Individual Tournament Regulations Refer to the OHSAA Website - www.ohsaa.org

- 11.1 All wrestlers with a .500 record or better from the current season (minimum of 12 matches) will be seeded with a maximum of 8 seeds per weight class.
- 11.2 The seeds will be placed on the preliminary bracket in accordance with the Rule 10 of the NFHS Wrestling Rule Book. Byes and non-seeded wrestlers will be placed on the bracket by the computer.
- 11.3 A wrestler may only be seeded in one weight class.
- 11.4 If a seeded wrestler drops out or fails to make weight:
 - 11.4.1 Seeded wrestlers will be rotated accordingly to the appropriate line (see 9.3-9.5).
 - 11.4.2 Non-seeded wrestlers' lines on the bracket will become byes if a bye is legal.
 - 11.4.3 If a bye is not permitted, a coin flip (or series of flips) will determine which line will become a bye, and which wrestler must be moved to make the bracket legal.
- 11.5 In accordance with NFHS Rule 10-3-2 there shall be no byes after the first round of competition in both the championship and consolation brackets. Note: The first round of the tournament in a particular weight class could be the quarterfinal or semifinal round depending on the number of entries.
- 11.6 Seeding Criteria:
 - 11.6.1 Returning state placer (1-3) at any weight class
 - 11.6.2 Returning state placer (4-8) at any weight class. A "New" (freshman or upper classman that was not a contender last year) wrestler that has more than 25 wins and has defeated a wrestler listed above him on the list and has a higher winning percentage will be seeded above the returning state place winner at any weight class (4-8).
 - *The coach must e-mail the credentials to the manager.
 - 11.6.3 Returning district placer (1-6) at any weight class. A "New" (Freshman or upper classman that was not a contender last year) wrestler that has more than 20 wins and has defeated a wrestler listed above him on the list and has a higher winning percentage than the returning district place winner will be seeded above the returning district place winner at any weight class (1-6).
 - 11.6.4 Tie-breakers:
 - The higher placer at each level earns the higher seed.
 - If two or more wrestlers have identical place finishes, the wrestler returning at the same weight earns the higher seed.
 - Previous year's tournament place finish MUST have been at an OHSAA tournament.
 - A returning placer can be from Division I, II, or III.
 - 11.6.5 Won/Loss record (by percentage) from current season (minimum of 12 matches).
 - In the event of a tie in percentage, the wrestler with the most wins will receive the higher seed.
 - If this does not break the tie, a coin-flip will determine the seed.
- 11.7 Seeding Meeting
 - A seeding meeting may be held after wrestlers have been seeded by criteria.
 - A coach may challenge a seed based on criteria and the coaches will then vote on the challenge.

INSTRUCTIONS TO ENTER ROSTER AND SEEDS ONLINE:

1. If you are not a “computer user” find an assistant, parent, friend or athlete to help you out.
2. Go to www.baumspage.com and click on **Online Entry** or **Login**. Please note the following:
 - a. All accounts from last year were retained, but the associations with schools and teams were cleared.
 - b. If you have an account, use that e-mail address and password to login.
 - c. If you do not have an account, click on Apply and create one.
3. Please set up your account **NOW**. You may finalize your roster later, but setting up and testing your account **NOW** will eliminate potential problems later.
 - a. If you forgot your password use the **Forget your Password** link to request a new one.
 - b. If you have problems click the **Help** link on the **Login Page** or use the **Contact Us** link.
 - i. **For immediate help** call **513-594-6154** or **740-517-0195**.
4. **Submit an “intended” roster early! Return any time before deadline to make changes!**
 - a. After login, use • **Coaches** • | **Select Teams** to claim your **School** and **Sport**.
 - b. Use • **Coaches** • | **Wrestling** | **Modify Athletes** to enter your **athlete’s names and grades**.
 - d. Use • **Coaches** • | **Wrestling** | **Submit Rosters** to enter wrestlers into their weight classes.
 - i. Click on the weight and **Select a wrestler**.
 - ii. Enter the appropriate tournament seeding information where applicable
 - e. Click **Submit Rosters** to submit your tournament entry form.
 - f. Use **Get Printable Roster** to print a copy for your records.
5. **The entry window will close precisely at 7:00 PM on Thursday, February 27th!**
 - a. You may login and make changes any time prior to the entry deadline!
 - b. Always click **Submit Rosters** to submit the changes!
6. **All entries and seeding criteria must be submitted via baumspage.com before 7:00 PM on Thursday, February 27th. Schools will be subject to a \$50 fine for wrestlers entered after the deadline!**
 - a. Please submit a tentative roster early! Then login again and finalize it before the deadline.
 - b. **After 7:00 PM Thursday, all wrestlers are locked into the weight class as submitted!**
 - c. The only exceptions will be for those scenarios outlined in **Section 10.3 of the OHSAA Individual Tournament Regulations**.
