Weigh Ins

- 2 scales will be used for weighing in contestants. Scales will be open to check weights from 3:30-4:00 on Thursday and Friday and 8:00-8:30am on Saturday morning.
- All wrestlers shall be present and remain in designated area
- Weigh-ins will be done by weight class beginning with 106 lbs and will begin with skin checks.
- Wrestlers get two tries on the first scale, then one try on each additional scale.
- Weigh ins will be completed in the Norwalk High School Auxiliary Gym.

General Information

Buses/Transportation

- Drop off for wrestlers will be at the back of Norwalk High School. Van parking will be located in the Performing Arts Center Parking lot located on the opposite side of the main entrance of Norwalk High School. A map of the school is included at the end of this packet. There will be designated parking for busses at Norwalk Middle School. A Shuttle for bus drivers will be provided.

Check-In

- Please use the back entrance to the high school and proceed to the auxiliary gym for check in and weigh-ins. Only the head coach may pick up your packet. Your packet will contain the following: Brackets and team information

- **All Personnel will check in: NO extra coaches, managers, or mat maids will be allowed entry-Do not try and bring extra personnel above the allotted number. They will NOT be given entry to the tournament!**

Media & Photographers

- All requests for media credentials at sectional/district tournaments shall be directed to the tournament manager in advance. Proper credentials must be presented for admission at pass gate

Tournament Procedural Information

- 3 mats will be used for all Sessions
- Warm-up area for wrestlers will be located behind the mezzanine bleachers. One locker room will be open for wrestlers. Norwalk High School will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Only wrestlers in uniform and coaches will be allowed on the floor.
- Only two coaches/team personal will be permitted mat side-this will strictly be enforced
- All wrestlers who are not on the mat competing or warming up will sit in the visitor bleachers. It is essential that wrestlers are not roaming the school and are seated in their assigned area when they are not wrestling! **All wrestlers are required to wear face masks and social distance when not wrestling**

Concessions

A concession stand will be provided during all sessions. Coolers for team meals will only be allowed in our cafeteria area. **There will be no crockpots allowed!**

Hospitality Room

There will be NO hospitality room provided. Concessions will be open and will sell items for coaches to purchase.

Professionalism of Coaches

It is the moral obligation of all Ohio Wrestling Coaches to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects credit upon their high school, their profession and themselves. Personal grooming and appropriate dress is a standard of professionalism. **The wearing of jeans, t-shirts, sweat suits, and warm-up suits (top or bottom, head wear and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA Sectional, District, or State Wrestling Tournaments and, therefore are prohibited. Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor.** Moral behavior and ethical conduct are part of winning and losing. Good sportsmanship, appearance, honor, and concern for the well-being of the competitors must be every coach's priority. The rules have been established in the spirit of this statement. **NO JEANS AND NO HATS....THANKS!**

Scoring/Awards

- 6 places will be scored-the top 4 place winners in each weight qualify for the OHSAA State Tournament
- There will be NO Awards presentation-Awards will be given to coaches
- Individual medals will be awarded to the top 6 place winners in each weight
- Team trophies will be awarded to the District Champion and Runner-Up team
- Medals will be awarded to the coach of the Champion and Runner-up Team
