## **Tournament Schedule**

Weigh-Ins: 2:00 pm

Wrestling Begins: 4:00 pm (Session 1-Championship rounds 1 & 2, Consolation round 1)

\*Weigh Outs-Will begin after the 145lb matches of consolation round 1 and will end ½ hour after the final match ends. Competitors cannot weigh in for Saturday until they have wrestled their final Friday match. Weigh outs will take place in locker rooms.

## **Weigh Ins**

- 3 scales will be used for weighing in contestants. Scales will be open to check weights from 1:15pm-1:45pm on Friday and 7:00am-7:15am on Saturday morning.
- All wrestlers shall be present and remain in designated area.
- Weigh-ins will be done by weight class beginning with 106 lbs and will begin with skin checks.
- Wrestlers get two tries on the first scale, then one try on each additional scale.
- Weigh ins will be completed in the Norwalk High School Auxiliary Gym.

## **General Information**

### **Buses/Transportation**

- Drop off for wrestlers will be at the **back** of Norwalk High School. Van parking will be located in the Performing Arts Center Parking lot located on the opposite side of the main entrance of Norwalk High School. A map of the school is included at the end of this packet. There will be designated parking for busses at Norwalk Middle School. A Shuttle for bus drivers will be provided if needed.

### **Check-In**

- On Friday, please use the back entrance to the high school and proceed to the auxiliary gym for check-in and weigh-ins. Only the head coach may pick up your packet. Your packet will contain the following: Brackets, team information, wristbands for mat access, and tickets for coaches for complimentary food at the concession stand. All extra personnel will have to pay the regular admission prices.

### **Team Wristband will be given as follows:**

<b>1-2 qualifiers (5 passes)</b>	<b>4 coach wristbands +1</b>
<b>3-5 qualifiers (6 passes)</b>	<b>4 coach wristbands +2</b>
<b>6 or more qualifiers (8 passes)</b>	<b>5 coach wristbands +3</b>

**Wristbands cannot be removed or altered, as it is your admittance to the tournament on Saturday.**

**No one is allowed on the floor or able to coach without a wristband on.**

### **Media & Photographers**

- All requests for media credentials at sectional/district tournaments shall be directed to the tournament manager in advance. Proper credentials must be presented for admission at pass gate

### **Tournament Procedural Information**

- 5 mats will be used for session 1-3 **Mats in the Main Gym & 2 Mats in the Aux Gym**
- 5 mats will be used for session 2-3 **Mats in the Main Gym & 2 Mats in the Aux Gym**
- 3 mats will be used for finals.
- Warm-up area for wrestlers will be located behind the mezzanine bleachers. Two locker rooms will be open for wrestlers. Lockers will be available, but Norwalk High School will not be responsible for lost or stolen items. Bring a lock to lock up your valuables.
- Only wrestlers in uniform and coaches with wristbands will be allowed on the floor.
- Only two coaches/team personal will be permitted mat side-this will strictly be enforced
- A bout board will be used in the main and auxiliary gyms to designate mat placement.

## Concessions

A concession stand will be run by the Norwalk Athletic Booster club and they will provide a wide variety of food for sale beginning at 3:00pm on Friday and all day Saturday. Coolers for team meals will only be allowed in our cafeteria area. **There will be no crockpots allowed!**

## Hospitality Room

This area is for coaches, officials, and tournament staff only. This area will always have someone in there to make sure that only those with wristbands are able to enter. The hospitality room will be in a new location this year. We will have water and light snacks; food will be provided in the evening on Friday and lunchtime on Saturday. Please be courteous and do not overindulge or take items to others outside of the hospitality room. Once the food is gone it will not be replaced.

## Professionalism of Coaches

It is the moral obligation of all Ohio Wrestling Coaches to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects credit upon their high school, their profession and themselves. Personal grooming and appropriate dress is a standard of professionalism. **The wearing of jeans, t-shirts, sweat suits, and warm-up suits (top or bottom, head wear and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA Sectional, District, or State Wrestling Tournaments and, therefore are prohibited. Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor.** Moral behavior and ethical conduct are part of winning and losing. Good sportsmanship, appearance, honor, and concern for the well-being of the competitors must be every coach's priority. The rules have been established in the spirit of this statement. **NO JEANS AND NO HATS....THANKS!**

## Scoring/Awards

- 6 places will be scored-the top 4 place winners in each weight qualify for the OHSAA State Tournament
- Individual medals will be presented to the top 6 place winners in each weight.
- Team trophies will be presented to the District Champion and Runner-Up team.
- Medals will be awarded to the coach of the Champion and Runner-up Team
- Awards will be handed out as they are ready behind the mezzanine bleachers.

## Dress Code for Awards

All wrestlers receiving a district award will wear his/her team's wrestling warm-ups at the time of the presentation.
