1.	Admission	\$6.00
2.	Parking (buses)	You will let athletes out at the Northwest Gate and be directed to the bus parking area. Enter off Adams Street parking area next to Hobart Arena.
3.	Concessions:	Concession stands will be open on each side under the stadium. Sandwiches, pizza, snacks and beverages will be available during the entire meet.
4.	Dressing Rooms:	Please come dressed and ready to run. Contact management ahead of time if this is a problem. Restrooms are located on both sides under the stadium.
5.	First Aid:	Each school should be prepared to handle any minor incidents. We will have a trainer available if you need assistance.
6.	Scoring:	For all events: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1
7.	Awards:	Established by OHSAA
8.	Field Events:	School issued implements must be certified upon your arrival. Shot and discus weigh-ins are adjacent to the Shot Put area in the SE corner of the stadium. All certified implements will be held until time for competition.
9.	Running Events:	Regular blocks will be provided. Teams that use Moye blocks will need to provide them.
10.	T-Shirts	Regional T-shirts will be on sale both days of competition.
11.	Time Schedule:	Calls will be given for all events on Wednesday during the preliminaries. There will be no calls made on Friday as the meet will be on a posted time schedule.

COACHES

- A. All non-participants must stay out of the infield (off the football field). No camps inside the fenced area of the stadium.
- B. All coaches must be in the stands or areas designated by meet **management** at all times.
- C. Coaches will not be permitted in the press box during the coarse of the meet. Direct all questions to meet officials.
- D. Decisions of officials will be final and without appeal, except possible action taken by the head finish judge or the referee.
- E. Note: Maximum length for spikes is ¹/₄ inch, cone shape, to be checked randomly in the bullpen. No tape or chalk can be used to mark track or runways. Cut tennis balls will be available. Batons will be furnished.
- F. **Review time schedule carefully.** The finals for the 4x800 relay will be on Wednesday. All other finals will be run on Friday.
- G. If your relay team or an individual that you coach is first in the final, you are requested to make the award presentation for that event at the awards area.
- H. Please police camp areas prior to leaving each day.
