Entry Deadline & Seed Nominations Entries and seed nominations must be submitted via baumspage.com before 7:00 PM, Thursday, February 25, 2021. Note that each wrestlers' overall record AND record without forfeits must be submitted. Wrestlers are locked into their weight class as of 7:00 PM Thursday. The preliminary seed nomination list will be posted on baumspage.com at 7:30 PM Thursday. Please review attached policy.

COVID Assessments Coaches are required to perform COVID assessments before departure from their home school.

Two certified scales will be available. If any wrestler needs to make scratch weight, please report that at team check-in.

Start Times Session 1 - Friday, February 26 2:00 PM (weight classes with more than 10 wrestlers per entry grid)
Session 2 - Saturday, February 27 9:00 AM (weight classes not wrestled on Friday)

Admission Two spectators per wrestler will be admitted. Tickets are \$10 per session and must be purchased online at <https://www.ohsaa.org/tickets>. Additional information will be sent to athletic directors once it is available.

Non competing wrestlers Wrestlers not competing on Friday will be permitted to enter the facility; however, in order to adhere to COVID capacity guidelines, these wrestlers **must** stay in the junior high gymnasium **at all times**. This same guideline applies to those wrestlers who are only wrestling on Friday for Saturday. Coaches are strongly encouraged to make alternative arrangements for non competing wrestlers. Coaches are also encouraged, when permissible, to have parents transport wrestlers to/from the tournament to help adhere to capacity guidelines.

Passes No school or league issued passes will be accepted.
1 wrestler - 2 coach passes
2-4 wrestlers - 3 coach passes
5-9 wrestlers - 4 coach passes
10-14 wrestlers - 5 coach passes

Seed Meeting The seed meeting will be held in person on Friday, February 26 at 12:15 PM. Please review the attached seed meeting guidelines carefully as it has changed. Head coaches only will be permitted to attend the seed meeting.

Concessions	Concessions will be available.
Team Food	Due to COVID protocols, absolutely no team food or drinks will be permitted in the facility. No coolers, no crockpots or other electrical food devices, etc.
Hospitality	A limited hospitality room will be available for coaches, officials and tournament workers.
Team Seating	All teams will be assigned an area in the junior high gymnasium. Only wrestlers on deck and wrestling will be permitted in the competition gymnasium.
Spectators	All spectators must follow COVID guidelines and protocols, including wearing a mask and social distancing at all times.
Livestream	Alexander High School is hoping to have this feature operational before the tournament.
Locker Rooms	Access to locker rooms will be limited and monitored. Coaches should encourage wrestlers to use only as needed. Wrestlers will not be permitted to congregate. Wrestlers should come dressed and ready to weigh-in immediately upon arrival.
Officials	Assigned by the OHSAA Southeast District Athletic Board.
Athletic Trainer	A certified athletic trainer will be available during the event.
Physician	A physician will be on site during weigh-ins to evaluate any skin related issues.
Weather Contingency	Plan A for Friday is a two hour delay; Plan B is to postpone Session 1 to Sunday with 1:00 PM start time Plan A for Saturday is a two hour delay; Plan B is to postpone Session 2 to Sunday with corresponding start times.
Professionalism of Coaches	<i>It is the moral obligation of all Ohio Wrestling Coaches to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects credit upon their high school, their profession and themselves. *Personal grooming and appropriate dress is standard of professionalism. The wearing of jeans, t-shirts, sweat suits and warm-up suits (top or bottom), head wear and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA Sectional, District or State Wrestling Tournaments and, therefore, are prohibited.* Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor. Moral behavior and ethical conduct are part of winning and losing. Good sportsmanship, appearance, honor, and concern for the well-being of the competitors must be every coach's priority. The Rules have been established in the spirit of this statement.</i>
