Team Food: There will be NO TEAM FOOD TABLES.

Passes: Personnel over what the SWDAB covers will have to pay admission.

Alternates: No alternate will gain free access to the Gym unless entered in the District.

Concessions: There will be full concessions for wrestling fans; No outside food for spectators will be permitted.

Parking: There will be a charge for parking this year per the SWDAB.

Hospitality: There will be No hospitality area for coaches this year.

Statisticians: Stats are not allowed in the wrestling area. They shall keep score from their seats, not at mat side.

Pics/Video: No pictures / video from the gym floor without media credentials.

Transportation: Bus Drivers will need proper identification for entry to the Gym.

Professionalism: The wearing of jeans, t-shirts, sweat suits and warm-up suits (top or bottom), head wear and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA Sectional, District or State Wrestling Tournaments and, therefore, are prohibited. Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor.
