Tournament Apparel: District wrestling apparel will be available
Cash Only please.

Facilities: Limited locker space is available. Bring a lock or keep valuables with you. Assignments for locker rooms are as follows:

- Locker Room #1 – Teams from Lehman Sectional
- Locker Room #2 - Teams from Lima CC Sectional
- Locker Room #3 – Teams from Blanchester Sectional
- Locker Room #4 – Teams from Covington Sectional

Awards: Team trophies will be presented to the Champion and Runner-up teams. District medals will be awarded to the top six placers in each weight class. Recipients must be in school issue uniform at the awards ceremony; no jeans or hats

State Qualifiers: Four wrestlers from each weight class and an alternate will qualify for the State Tournament to be held March 8-10, 2018 at the Schottenstein Center.

2018 OHSAA Regulations Please review these regulations prior to the tournament paying special attention to the ALTERNATE information

Trainer: An assigned, on-site athletic trainer and doctor will be available throughout the meet.

Coaches: Each school will receive the following number of coaches' tickets:

1-6 Qualifying wrestlers	4 tickets
7-10 Qualifying wrestlers	5 tickets
11+ Qualifying wrestlers	6 tickets

These tickets are for coaches, managers, stats, bus driver, and support personnel **who arrive with the team.**

Cheerleaders---a maximum of **6 IN UNIFORM**, will be admitted and they must be accompanied by their advisor.

This may be different than your sectional, so please plan accordingly.

Coaches' Dress Code: The Tournament Dress Code will be enforced at the District Championships. The wearing of jeans, t-shirts, sweat suits, warm-up suits, headwear, and similar apparel is not considered suitable. Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor.

Contestant Each team will need to pick up an envelope at the pass gate upon arrival. The envelope will contain tickets for the qualifying wrestler, coaches/support personnel based on district policy (see "Coaches" section above).

Parking: Parking for teams and officials will be in the lot on the northeast side of Hobart Arena. See the map that accompanies this information. **This is parking for teams and officials only---space is limited!** The Pass Gate is located right next to this lot and is also marked on the map.

Check-in: To enter, each wrestler will need to present their ticket at the pass gate on both Friday and Saturday.

**If for any reason a wrestler needs to leave the building during the competition, they must have their hand stamped for re-entry.

Re-Entry: Wrestlers, stats, and coaches must enter and exit through the Pass Gate on the northeast side of Hobart Arena. Your hand must be stamped to gain re-entry to the arena. Please try to keep this to a minimum and stress with your fans/parents that there is **NO RE-ENTRY ALLOWED FOR SPECTATORS!**

Alternates: Alternates must purchase a ticket. If they wrestle, a refund will be issued.

Floor Access: The only persons permitted in the wrestling area will be the wrestler and up to two coaches. Media with approved credentials will also be permitted on the floor. No stats will be allowed on the floor.

Statisticians: Statisticians are considered support personnel and may use one of the pass gate tickets allocated to your team. Stats are not allowed in the wrestling area. They should take stats from their seats, **NOT STANDING OR SITTING AT THE WALL/EDGE OF THE FLOOR.**

Bus Drivers: Bus drivers will need a pass to enter.

Pictures/ Video: There will be **NO** pictures/video from the Arena floor
No video without official Press Credentials!

Concessions: There will be a full concession stand for wrestling fans and participants. **NO** outside food for spectators will be permitted!

Hospitality: Hospitality rooms are a perk that is not provided by all districts. **This year our hospitality room will have restrictions. Food and refreshments for coaches will be limited and monitored.** Please be respectful of hospitality workers for their time involved in preparing this service for all of you. Hospitality tickets will be provided in your check-in packet, quantities as follows...

2 for 1-6 participating wrestlers

3 for 7-10 participating wrestlers

4 for 11+ participating wrestlers

The hospitality room is located in the Multi-Purpose Room on the northwest side of the arena (marked on the map included).
