Thursday, February 24 Seed Meeting

- Prior to seeding the weight class, all requests for nomination of seeds will be evaluated and approved or rejected by a vote of the coaches.
- Final seeding will be done at the seed meeting.
- Challenges will be allowed for head-to-head and higher placement in the same weight class at a common tournament.
- Disposition of challenges will be by coach's vote or concession by the coach of the nominated seed under challenge.
- Brackets will be drawn during the meeting, but will not be official until after weigh-ins are official.

Saturday, February 26

7:30 Pass Gate and Weigh-in Rooms Open/Scales Open to Check Weight

8:00 Weigh-ins by weight class.

**The weigh-in shall proceed through all weight classes, beginning at 106 lbs. and concluding at 285 lbs. Contestants may step on and off the first scale two times. Contestants who fail to make weight on the first scale, shall immediately step on each available scale one time in an attempt to make weight.*

8:30 Doors open for Spectators (Must purchase pre-sale ticket online)

9:00 Championship Round 1 *Weight classes with more than 8 will be wrestled first.

**Please have wrestlers ready when called to the mat. Keep others in the stands or in the warm-up area. Only two coaches or a coach and a wrestler are permitted in the two chairs at the edge of the mat. Statisticians in the stands.*

Professionalism of Coaches

It is the moral obligation of all Ohio wrestling coaches to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects credit upon their high school, their profession and themselves. Personal grooming and appropriate dress is a standard of professionalism. The wearing of jeans, t-shirts, sweat suits and warm-up suits (top or bottom), head wear and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA sectional, district or state wrestling tournaments and, therefore, are prohibited. Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor. Moral behavior and ethical conduct are part of winning and losing. Good sportsmanship, appearance, honor, and concern for the well-being of the competitors must be every coach's priority. The rules have been established in the spirit of this statement.

Clinton Massie SW DIVISION II WRESTLING SECTIONAL **INCLEMENT WEATHER PLAN February 26, 2022**

In the case of bad weather for the sectional tournament we will contact each school through the Athletic Directors or Head Coaches and enact one of the following plans:

- Plan A: If bad weather is imminent for Saturday morning, but we can wrestle on Saturday afternoon, we will wrestle the first session at the time the second session is scheduled and wrestle the second session on Sunday afternoon.
- Plan B: If bad weather cancels Saturday, we should be able to complete our sectional on Sunday, February 27, following the same schedule as Saturday. (Weight - scratch +3)
- Plan C: If wrestling is canceled both Saturday and Sunday then we will wrestle the morning session on Monday evening and afternoon session on Tuesday evening.
