EQUIPMENT:

1. A limited number starting blocks and relay batons will be available if needed.
2. **Tape may *not* be used to mark the track or runways. *Chalk only!***
3. **A maximum of 1/4" for spikes will be permitted on the track / runway surfaces. *This includes starting blocks!***

FOOTBALL FIELD: **There is to be absolutely no warming-up or camping-out on the football field nor at the baseball field!**

NOTES TO COACHES/ATHLETES

I ATHLETE REPORTING AREA FOR RUNNING EVENTS

The "Athlete Reporting Area" for all running events is in the Southeast corner of the stadium by the baseball backstop with the exception of the 200m Dash and the 300m Hurdles which will check in at the respective starting lines.

II. WEIGHT IMPLEMENTS

Weight implements will be inspected and weighed at the concession stand nearest the shot put in the Southwest corner of the stadium.

III. TEAM CAMPS:

There are to be no team camps within the track, in the east stands, nor within the baseball field.

IV. ELECTRONIC DEVICES:

Athletes are NOT permitted to have any electronic devices within the track or field event venues

V. SPIKES

1/4" spikes only in both shoes and starting blocks

VI. WARM-UPS:

There are to be NO warm-ups on the football or baseball fields

VII. TRACK/RUNWAY MARKINGS:

Chalk only is to be used on track and runway surfaces including the high jump

VIII. FIELD EVENT VENUES:

Field event venues will open one (1) hour prior to the start of competition and only with approved/inspected implements

IX. TIMING RE-CALL

Note, by rule, in the event of a malfunction by the timing crew system, that timing crews have the authority to recall a race to prevent runners from the unnecessary task of completing a race and having to re-run the race at a later time. This rule is only in effect with the pre-approval of the Games Committee. Timing crews and/or tournament managers and/or referees (in their pre-meet meeting with coaches) should alert coaches to what device will be used to re-call said race.

X. UNIFORM WAIVER

Do you have an athlete who requires a waiver to the typical uniform regulations for religious, medical, or other reasons? If so, you MUST obtain a waiver from Dale Gabor, Director of Track and Field for the OHSAA, in order for that athlete to compete. This is a coaches' responsibility and will be enforced according to the rule. There are no appeals or exceptions to this regulation.
