1. All entries will be done online via Baum's Page using [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com). Please visit the Baum's Page website to familiarize yourself with how the entry process works. The entry window is currently open until April 30. The on-line entry window will close at 9:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 30. Lane assignments will be handed out when you arrive. Late scratches may be emailed to Tom Tucker at [ttucker@woh.rr.com](mailto:ttucker@woh.rr.com) by Friday 3:00 p.m. Any late scratches the morning of the meet need to be done immediately upon your arrival, but we ask you turn in by Friday 3:00 p.m. if all possible. Tom Tucker can also be contacted at 419.680-8200 .
2. Entry fee of \$200 (\$100 each for boys and girls). Please send if you have not done so already.
3. Please remind bus drivers to enter and park the bus from the north gate and not the main entrance/parking lot in front of the stadium. The north parking lot is right next to our discus event. This north parking lot is off Aigler Blvd., which is off of Northwest Street. Please call if questions.
4. **TEAM AREAS:** Teams may set up their camps in the north end of the stadium home stands, or on the grounds to the north outside the track, in the visiting stands, or in the grassy area outside the fence at the finish line. NO CAMPS will be allowed in the infield area inside the track or underneath the stadium bleachers.
5. **BULLPEN/CHECK IN:** For all running events will be at the north end of the track/stadium by the starting line for the 100 M.
6. The running track is latex. Flats or shoes with a maximum of 1/4" are permitted on this surface.
7. Contestants must wear school issued uniforms with school issued numbers. We will follow the National Federation Rules for tights and undershirts, especially the relay teams. There is to be no lettering on undershirts. Please follow the rules on maximum number of logos.
8. **SHOT & DISCUS:** 3 throws in preliminaries; top 7 go to the finals; 3 throws in the finals; all 6 throws count in the final results; *contestants may use common implements. Implement weigh-ins will be just inside the field house and will be weighed in from 7:30 – 8:20 a.m. as you arrive.*
9. **JUMPS:**
  - a) Long Jump: Open pit for preliminaries from 8:50 a.m. to 10:20 a.m. for both girls and boys; 3 jumps in prelims; top 7 advance to finals for 3 more jumps; all 6 jumps count in final results. Finals run throughs from 10:20-10:40. Finals to begin at 10:40. Pit will close at 11:35 p.m.
  - b) Pole Vault: boys will start at 9' and 6" until 12'; at 12 ' bar will be moved by agreement of the remaining contestants; continuing flights (5 alive) will be used: girls will start at 6' (Boys can start while girls are vaulting)
  - c) High Jump: starts at 4' 4" for girls and 5' 6" for boys, and moves in 2" increments until completion; continuing flights (5 alive) will be used. (Boys will jump after completion of girls jumps)
10. The 400 relay exchange colors are all yellow. The 800 relay exchange colors are red, red, and yellow.

11. The 3200 relay will be staggered for two curves.
12. The 1600 relay will be staggered the first three turns.
13. The 400 and 300 hurdles will be run in two sections with the fast section last.
14. The 800 will be run from a two-turn stagger.
15. The 1600 and 3200 will be staggered for one curve and the contestants will be boxed two per lane.
- 16. Hospitality food items and drinks will be provided for coaches and workers throughout the day in the upstairs of the field house.**
17. Admission charge is \$7.00 for adults and \$5.00 for students for all day.
18. Trophies will be presented to 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams as well as to the outstanding female and male performers. Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be given to 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers, and ribbons to 4<sup>th</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place finishers. Medals and Ribbons will be placed in packets for each team. Coaches can pick up their awards packet at the conclusion of the meet in the press box.
19. The Outstanding Performer Award will be determined on a point total basis. First place will equal 10 points, second place 8 points, third place 6 points, etc. Relays will count the same as individual events in the point total. An athlete can earn 30 points for breaking or tying a stadium record (20 points for stadium record and 10 points for invitational record), and 10 points for breaking or tying an invitational record. For example: If an athlete finishes first in four events (40 points), breaks a stadium record (30 points), and breaks an invitational record that is not a stadium record (10 points), he/she would earn 80 points.
20. Please make marks for exchange zones and area with tennis balls. NO chalk or tape please!!! Chalk or tape can be used to mark the high jump approach. No marks of any kind can be used on the long jump approach surface or the pole vault approach surface.
21. **Please keep the high jump and long jump area clear of all coaches, and non-contestants.**
22. Please do not wear spikes into the bleachers on either side of the field.
23. Coaches if any concerns or appeals they should be directed to the meet referee, Mr. David Sabo
- 24. There will be a concession stand open all day operated by our Athletic Booster Club.**
- 25. Invite T-Shirts and Long Sleeve Shirts will be available to purchase.**
26. Scoring will be 10-8-6-4-2-1.
- 27. The following boys and girls teams are entered for the 2014 Bellevue Elks Invitational Track Meet: *Bellevue, Fremont Ross, Huron, Maumee, Norwalk, Ontario, Perkins, and Willard***
28. Once competition begins, a coach may substitute for an injured or ill athlete only. However, the athlete being removed may no longer participate in the meet.
- 29. In the 3200 Relay, all participants will group and be fed into the relay race from the outside of the track to avoid congestion in the long jump area.**
30. We will follow the state format for advancement to the finals. Top (2) runners from each heat will advance and then the next (4) best times in either heat will also advance.
