

To all the coaches & athletes participating in the 61<sup>st</sup> Berea-Kiwanis Titan Relays:

As you know, the facility we use for the Titan Relays is Baldwin Wallace's Finnie Stadium. This is a wonderful facility, with an amazing, MONDO track...making it the fastest track in Ohio. The MONDO surface is an extremely expensive surface, and BW rightfully seeks to take great care of the track. Head Coach Matt Cole sent over the following note regarding the use of the track & runways. Please abide by his requests. Absolutely NO CHALK will be permitted. Officials will be informed to not allow the use of chalk, so please bring tape (which should be removed when finished, tennis balls, or other temporary spotting items that won't damage the track & leave marks.

A message from Matt Cole...

"The only thing I ask is that all TAPE be removed from the track, PV/LJ runways, HJ area and exchange zones at the end of the meet. I also ask that NO ONE uses sidewalk chalk (or marking chalk of any kind anywhere) inside the stadium or runways. I DON'T want to come back Saturday night and see our beautiful track looking like it was the site an elementary school playground.... Thanks for understanding!
