Coach & Athlete Information:

- Coaches are to wear masks or facial coverings at all times during the event. Athletes are to wear them at all times except for when warming up or actively competing.
- Participants are required to wear school-issued uniforms.
- Participants are required to wear flats or $\frac{1}{4}$ " or $\frac{1}{8}$ " spikes.
- Shot put and discus are located just outside the track in the southwest corner behind the concession stand.
- High jump and long jump are located at the North end of the track. Pole vault is located at the South end of the track.
- Scoring will be as follows: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1
- Shot put, discus, and long jump will have four (4) attempts and no finals.
- Hurdle marks for 100/110 are yellow/blue, and 300 are red.
- 4 x 100 meter relay exchange zones are yellow.
- 4 x 200 meter relay exchange zones are red, then yellow.
- 4 x 400 meter relay exchange zones are red, then blue.
- 4 x 800 meter relay exchange zones are blue.
- Please make marks for exchange zones and field events with tennis balls if necessary. NO chalk or tape will be permitted on the track or runways.

Spectator Information:

- **There is a limit of two (2) spectators per athlete in order to help with social distancing.**
- Admission will be \$6.00 for all spectators sold at the gate (no passes of any kind accepted).
- Spectators are to wear masks or facial coverings at all times during the event other than when actively eating or drinking.
- Spectators should sit within the designated section for their team.

General Information:

- There will be a concession stand on site with prepackaged food and drinks available.
- There will also be event t-shirts for sale on site.
