Dear Coach,

This letter confirms your entry into the Tornado Invitational on Friday, April 15, 2022. The meet will feature a total of nine boys' and girls' teams. Please plan to arrive at Crater Stadium no later than 4:00 PM. **Buses are asked to park** and unload kids in the area directly behind the home stands and press box. All visiting teams are asked to sit in sections on the visitor side/backstretch. **No teams are permitted to sit in the band shell.** As there are no locker rooms available, teams are encouraged to bring bleacher canopy tents or utilize their bus in inclement weather. Please only ¼" spikes on track. There will be a **coaches meeting** in the east locker room (finish line end) at **4:15 PM**.

**Entries will be done online at [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com).** Please communicate any scratches and/or changes via email (contact info below) prior to 2 pm on Friday. No changes will be accepted after the coaches meeting.

**Entry fee** is \$80 per team (boys and girls) total of \$160.

**Field Event Update: Due to the number of competitors, we will do "4 and Score" instead of 3 and Finals in Shot, Discus, and LJ. The order will remain the same: Boys Shot, Girls Discus, Boys LJ to start.**

**Field Events will begin at 4:30 pm with the 1<sup>st</sup> call at 4:15.** ~~Athletes competing in shot put, discus and long jump will have 3 attempts. The top seven will move to finals and receive 3 additional attempts.~~ The starting height for the pole vault and the high jump will be determined by the performances entered. Boys long jump will be an open pit from 4:30-5:00 pm with finals immediately after (Girls long jump will follow).

**Running Events will begin at 5 PM with Semi-finals in 100/110 H and 100 dash. Winner of each heat and next three fastest times will advance.** Semi-finals will be followed by the 4x800 Relay. All events thereafter will be finals, run in sections with the fastest heat first. Attached you will find a copy of the order of events.

SCHOOLS PARTICIPATING: *Barnesville, Cambridge, Canton South, Claymont, Dover, Lake, McKinley, St. Clairsville, TriValley, and Washington, Ridgewood*

There will be a Championship award, and awards for high point boy and girl, and individual medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places with ribbons going to places 3<sup>rd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup>.
