Teams: Calvert, Fostoria, Genoa, Hopewell-Loudon, Liberty Benton, Maumee, Monroeville, New Riegel, Old Fort, Scott, Seneca East, Springfield, St. Ursula (Girls Only), Tuscarawas Central Catholic, and Waite. (14 Girls Teams, 13 Boys Teams)

Entries: All schools must enter their entire rosters and all entries using the online registration at [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com). The deadline for registration is Thursday, April 22, 2021 at 7:00PM.

Changes: Will be handled Saturday morning. Please utilize the scratch sheet provided on [baumspage.com](http://baumspage.com) and turn these in on arrival to the press box.

Coaches Meeting: In the football locker room @ 8:30AM

Field Events: Will begin @ 9AM. Check the time schedule for specific details. Contestants will have 4 attempts with no finals in the shot put, discus, and long jump. The high jump and pole vault will be 5 alive. All field events will have the top seeded contestants going last.

Running Semi-Finals: Will begin @ 10AM in the following events:

- 100m hurdles
- 110m hurdles
- 100m dash
- 4x800m Relay Finals
- 200m dash.

The 4x800m relay finals will be held in between the 100m and 200m dash semis. The finals will begin, 20 minutes after the conclusion of the Semi-Finals. This time may be adjusted due to weather or if we are ahead or behind schedule. Listen for announcements on the P.A.

Fees: Check to see if your athletic director has paid your entry fee of \$200.00 (\$100/girls, \$100/boys). If not, have them make it payable to Fostoria Athletic Department and send to Michele Wolf, A.D., Fostoria High School, 1001 Park Avenue, Fostoria, OH 44830.

Admission: Adults - \$7.00 Students - \$5.00

Camp Sites: There will not be dressing room facilities available so remind your athletes to come dressed. Athletes will not be allowed to enter the area under the stadium. You are also asked to stay off the football field. No teams will be permitted to set up camp in the area inside the track (football field) and are asked to clean up their area before leaving. The facility has an all-weather surface for running and you are asked to have spikes no longer than ¼". No chalk or tape is permitted on the track surface. All teams are reminded to bring their own batons for relay races.

Concession: There will be a concession stand available.

Restroom Facilities: Located on the side of the concession stand for ladies and on the west end of the stadium for men.

Results: If you want a hard copy of the results just stop by the press box at the conclusion of the meet. Results will also be posted on [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com) throughout the meet.

Awards: Individual awards should be picked up by the head coach at the conclusion of the meet in the east concession stand. We will have awards for 8 places in each event. Coaches, PLEASE pick up your awards in the press box before leaving the stadium.

Scoring: We will score 8 places in each event: 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.
