## **2. Time schedule**

- a. 8:45 am. Coaches meeting will be held in the boys locker room.**
- b. All field events will begin at 9:00 am.**
  - i. Shot Put (3 member team) - Boys first then Girls to follow (4 attempts)**
  - ii. Discus (3 member team) - Girls first then Boys to follow (4 attempts)**
  - iii. High Jump (3 member team)**
    - 1. Boys first then Girls to follow**
      - a. Boys start at 5'0"**
      - b. Girls start at 4'2"**
  - iv. Long Jump (3 member team)**
    - 1. Girls open pit: 9:00 am - 10:15 am (4 attempts)**
    - 2. Boys open pit: 10:15 am -11:30 am (4 attempts)**
  - v. Pole Vault (2 member team)**
    - 1. Girls and Boys will run simultaneously. The bar starts at 6'6".**
- c. Running events will begin at 10:00 and continue on a rolling time schedule.**
  - i. Girls will always compete before the Boys**
    - Girls 4 x 100 Meter / Boys 4 x 110 Meter Shuttle Hurdles (Height at 30")**
    - JV 1600 (Scored)**
    - 4 x 200 Meter Relay**

## **3. Scoring/Results and Awards and Results**

- d. Each first and second place girls and boys team will receive a trophy. Trophies will be handed out to the top two girls and boys teams on the track below the press box after scoring is complete.**

#### **4. Team Areas**

- a. Team camp areas are to be set up under the home bleachers or around the visitor bleacher areas. Please do not set up in front of the long jump or pole vault pits as this will be distracting to the competitors. You may also set up on the grass practice field.**
- b. Absolutely no camps in the locker rooms or any portion of the track/football field.**

#### **5. Team Announcements/Coaches Reminders**

- a. *Admission will be \$5.00 for adults and \$3.00 for students***
- b. A certified trainer will be at the event. Drinking water and ice for injuries will be available.**
- c. No throwing of objects in the stadium. (i.e. footballs, frisbees, tennis balls)**
- d. Coaches and non-participating athletes will not be permitted inside the fenced area of the track during the running of the meet.**
- e. Concessions will be available.**
- f. No food or drink (except water) is permitted on the track or field area.**
- g. Public restrooms are available and are located to the left of the concession stand.**
- h. All spiked shoes must be removed prior to entering the locker rooms or restrooms.**
- i. Common shots, discus, and batons will be used during competition.**
- j. All relay teams must report to the clerk of course by the second call.**
- k. All track spikes must be 1/4 inch in length or less. This will be checked.**
- l. Athletes' uniforms need to match for relay events.**
- m. No tape on the track.**
- n. Hospitality room will be provided for coaches and volunteers.**
- o. Souvenir t-shirts will be available for purchase.**
