Dear Coaches,

Thank you for attending this year's Sarah Robinson Relays. Below you will find preliminary meet information. Also included are the schedule of events and a facility map. This information is subject to change, especially as we maneuver COVID-19 restrictions. Attending schools will be notified of any changes as soon as possible via email.

Location

Lakewood Local High School, 9331 Lancer Road SE Hebron, OH 43025
(Stadium located across Lancer Road from HS, next to the MS)

Teams

Big Walnut, Granville Christian, Lakewood, Liberty Union, Mount Vernon, Newark Catholic, Northridge, Pickerington Central

Entries

Entries shall be submitted via Baumspage.com. Entries are due by midnight on Wednesday, April 21st. Scratches can be addressed with the timing company prior to the start of field events.

Entry Guidelines:

- One team of four for each running relay event.
- One team of two for each field event relay.

Facilities

Two restroom facilities are located within the stadium area. The concession building will be open for purchase of food and beverages. No locker rooms will be available.

Team Camps

Teams may set up camps in the grass areas outside of the track. No team camps are permitted in the bleachers.

Buses

Buses may drop off athletes in the alleyway south of the stadium and continue to the bus parking area in front of the middle school.

Warmups

Teams may use the turf field or the track for warmups. We ask that teams use the field parallel to yard markers to reserve space for others. The track may be used prior to the start of running events, or in areas not in use during the meet (i.e. outside lanes during distance events). A bike trail is located NW of the stadium, at the intersection of Route 40 and Lancer Road.

Equipment

- Starting blocks will be provided.
- Implements will NOT be provided.
- Implement weigh-in will be at the shed between the shot put and discus rings.
- Chalk is NOT permitted for use on track or field event areas.
- Spikes may not exceed ¼”.

Timing

Fully Automatic Timing (FAT) will be provided courtesy of Brophy Event Management. Results will be posted to Baumspage after the meet.

Scoring

10-8-6-4-2-1

Awards

- Medals for the top three (3) placers in each relay event.
- Trophies for the top two (2) boys and girls teams.

Spectators

Spectator parking is located in the front high school parking lot. Spectator seating is available in the bleachers on both sides of the track. Spectators are not permitted inside the track's outer fence. We ask that spectators wear masks and practice social distancing from those who live outside their household. Additional COVID-19 requirements may be posted at the entry gate.

Admission

A maximum of four (4) tickets may be purchased for each athlete. Tickets must be purchased online in advance via HomeTown Ticketing (use code “LHSTRACK”) – <https://www.lakewoodlocal.k12.oh.us/On-lineTicketSales.aspx>.
