**(NO PRELIMS)**

**Admission: \$7.00 for adult, \$5 for student/senior citizens**

BOYS & GIRLS TEAMS ENTERED: BENEDICTINE (boys only), BLACK RIVER (boys only), CLYDE, EDISON, ELYRIA, ELYRIA CATHOLIC, HURON, LUTHERAN WEST, ST. MARYS CC, WAUSEON, WILLARD

**Check in:** 8:30am-9:30am in the middle room of the stadium (coaches only) for packets, scratches, implement weigh in and breakfast. No coaches meeting needed unless something come up.

**IF BRING YOUR OWN STARTING BLOCKS MAKE SURE YOUR SCHOOLS NAME IS ON THEM.**

1. Enter your 2 participants for each event on Baumspage. Be aware of the closing date and scratch date.  
**Remember there are no prelims this year. YOU MAY ENTER 2 RELAYS FOR MORE PARTICIPATION.**
2. Lane assignments will be handed out when you arrive and turn in all scratches when you arrive or on Baumspage by 7pm Thursday night.
3. Shot and Discus - (3 flights of 7 throwers) **4 throws, NO FINALS**. Top throwers in the last flight.
3. Jumps: a) Long jump - **4 jumps** (open pit 1.5 hours, boys & girls), **NO FINALS**.  
b) High Jump bar starts at 4' 2" for girls 5' 4" for boys.  
c) Pole Vault bar starts at 9' 0"-boys, 6' 0"-girls, moving 6" at a time.

All races will be timed using FAT, heats will be set up slow to fast. **NO PRELIMS, ALL FINALS**

4. 100, 200, 400m dash, (100m, 110m and 300m hurdles) with the last heat, the fastest, involving 8 participants.
5. Relays:
  - a) 3200m - lanes through two turns then California exchange (blue exchanges) 1 heat
  - b) 400m-yellow exchange zones - lanes the entire race (3 heats)
  - c) 800m-red then yellow exchange zones- lanes the entire race (3 heats)
  - d) 1600m –blue exchange zones- First exchange in lanes, second runner cuts after the curve, then California exchange for third and fourth runner (3 heats)

**REMINDER: YOU MAY ENTER 2 RELAYS FOR MORE PARTICIPATION**

6. Only coaches may be on the infield. Everyone else must be on the outside of the track or in the stands. THE FINISH LYNX TIMING DEVICE WILL BE IN USE. IT'S IMPORTANT EVERYONE STAY OUT OF THE INFIELD and NOT CROSS THE FOOTBALL FIELD so timers and officials may see around the track.

7. Spikes - 1/4 or 1/8 only. Please do not wear spikes in the stands.

8. All running contestants must report to the clerk of course at the southwest end of the track (across from the concession stand) and field event contestants must report to the field event judge, **by the second call or be scratched.**

9. Remind your competitors in a field event that he or she must tell the event judge that they are leaving for a running event.

10. **Awards** will be handed out to the athletes at the podium. The top 8 will be called to the podium as soon as event results are available after each event. If your athlete does not show up to the podium their awards will be at the awards table out on the field **after** the meet.

#### DETERMINATION OF OUTSTANDING ATHLETE:

1. Assign points earned in individual events/divide relay points by 4(four).
2. Add 10 additional points for new invite record, add 2.5 points for relay record.
4. Add 5 additional points for tying an invite record, add 1 point for relays.

**Officials:** Andrew Morfier & Phil Cloud-starters, Mike Martin- clerk of course, Ray Wasson-long jump, Bob Knoll-high jump, David Downs-pole vault, Robert Smalling-Discus, Robert Delauder-shot put.

**Bull Pen-** the bull pen is located at the West end of the track, across from the concession stand. Athletes are asked to check in no later than the second call so they have time to get their hip number. The hip number should be on their **right hip**.

**Team camps- You may set up in the visitors stands or anywhere around/under the visitors stands.**

Team camps may **NOT** be located under the home stands or around the South side of the home stadium.

**Busses** should drop the athletes off on the visitor stand side of the stadium and then park in the very North parking lot of the school. Parking is limited so most of the spectators will need to park also North of the school.
