Subject: Bill Krause Memorial Invitational

Enclosed is the information and entry materials for our Bill Krause Memorial Invitational scheduled for **Saturday, April 20, 2019**. Please notice the starting time for our coaches' meeting is 10:15 a.m. Track facilities will be open by 10:00 a.m. The Invitational is at Mayer Field on the campus of Heidelberg University, which sets between Greenfield Street and Main Street on the Heidelberg University Campus. On the day of the event teams are encouraged to drop their athletes off, no earlier than 10:00 a.m. at the Greenfield Street Entrance and park their buses at the National Machinery Parking Lot just to the east of the track facility.

The entry fee is \$100 per team (\$200 for both). Make all checks payable to the Tiffin City Board of Education, and mail to the attention of *Patty Davis*, 300 South Monroe Street, Tiffin, 44883 as soon as possible. **Entries this year must be done "Online" - same is true for scratches - see attached information.**

Entries are due by Friday, April 19th at 11:00 a.m. with no scratch window.

The coaches' meeting will be held in the Fox Den, located on the lower floor of the press box building. No athletes will be permitted in the Fox Den. **No spikes will be permitted in the press box.**

Coffee and donuts will be available in the morning. We will have lunch available at the break between sessions in the Fox Den where the coaches' meeting was held. The concession stand will be open to the public and participants all day. T-shirts will be sold.

The on-field training room will be located in a medical tent and will be open and available for all track athletes. A certified athletic trainer will be on hand all day.

The boys' *long jump*, girls' *high jump*, girls' *shot put*, and boys' *discus* and boys' pole vault will start at 11:00 a.m. Pole Vaulters can begin checking in their poles at 10:00 a.m. Each person will receive three throws in the shot and discus and three jumps in the long jump. The long jump, shot put and discus will be run in flights. The top nine competitors in each of these events will go into the finals. Semi-finals for the running events will start at 12:00 p.m., with the top eight times moving on to the finals.

We will be scoring eight places (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1) with plaques awarded to First place for both individual and relay events and ribbons awarded to second through eighth place finishers in all events.

Coaches' Note - Competitors must use ¼" or smaller pyramid spikes. No Christmas tree spikes or needle spikes will be permitted.

General Information

- 1. Spikes must be ¼" or smaller pyramid spikes - No Christmas tree spikes or needles.**
- 2. Coaches' meeting at 10:15 a.m. at the Fox Den in the Press Box Building.**
- 3. You may enter two individuals in all events.**
- 4. Locker room space is not available, please come dressed to compete.**
- 5. No music boxes in stadium area. Please leave them on buses.**
- 6 Restrooms and concessions available - T-shirts will be on sale.**
- 7. Relay teams are asked not to use chalk when marking exchange zones. Please use tongue depressors and/or tennis balls.**
- 8. No athletes on the infield. Only participants at field event areas. Exception is at the discus area which is across Main Street outside of the track oval.**
- 9. All awards can be picked up in the Fox Den at the end of the meet.**
- 10. Long Jump - All jumpers get three (3) attempts. The top nine move into the finals.**
- 11. Common implements will be used. All throwers will receive 3 throws. The top nine move into the finals.**
- 12. Bull pen is located at the NE corner of the track.**
- 13. We have a very, very limited grassy area for team tents. No tents inside the track oval.**
- 14. Results will be available on Baum's Page shortly after the Boys 4x400 Relay.**
