Just remember, if you want their name listed in the heat sheets you are going to have to e-mail them to me before 10pm on Thursday night.

\*We will not be running Semi-Finals in this meet. We will seed the heats according to times submitted by the coaches and all placing will be based on FAT Finish-lynx timing.
