TRACK AND FIELD
MEET INFORMATION**

ONLINE ENTRIES: Entries will be submitted online using www.baumspage.com. Entries are due by 12:00 Noon on the day of the meet. Heats will be set according to times submitted with the hot heat last. Please make sure that your Baum's page roster includes the name for all of your athletes to satisfy the OHSAA requirement for providing roster information.

FIELD EVENTS: Start at 4:30

The first round will be as follows:

- BOYS SHOT
- GIRLS DISCUS
- GIRLS HIGH JUMP (starting height 4' 0") followed by BOYS (starting height 5' 0")
- BOYS LONG JUMP followed by GIRLS
- POLE VAULT: BOYS and GIRLS (Run together; scored separately; starting height 6' 6")

RUNNING EVENTS: Start at 4:45

- BOYS and GIRLS 4 X 800 RELAYS will be run together if agreeable with visiting coaches
- BOYS and GIRLS 3200-METER RUN will be competed together if agreeable with visiting coaches unless the number of entries necessitate running them separately

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Our track is an eight lane track and we request spikes no bigger than ¼" be used.
- Please use tennis balls for relay exchanges – NO tape or chalk.
- Field event changes can be made at the event site.
- Report all running scratches upon arrival to the pressbox – finish line end on the 2nd floor.
- Barring any equipment issues, all times will be FAT and a printed copy of the complete results will be made available immediately following the completion of the meet. Results will also be posted on Baum's page that evening.
- There will be a concession stand available with food and drinks.

Athletes will be expected to wear masks and keep socially distant when not actively competing or warming up. Coaches will be expected to wear masks at all times. For the safety of everyone, no one will be allowed near the finish line except those individuals specifically assigned to work there by meet management. All others should be outside the fence surrounding the track.

As far as spectators are concerned, they will be expected to follow all current health orders and safety requirements including mask wearing. We do not anticipate approaching our stadium capacity for this meet, so we are not limiting the number of spectators at this time. Tickets can be purchased at the meet.
