- TEAMS Bowling Green, Clyde, Edison, Sandusky, Perkins
- ENTRY FEE \$125 (Make check payable to Perkins High School)
- ENTRIES: All entries will be done online via **Baum's Page** using www.baumspage.com. Please visit the Baum's Page website to familiarize yourself with how the entry process works. The entry window will be from April 22 – May 1. The on-line entry window will close at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 1, 2012. Any late scratches the morning of the meet need to be done immediately upon your arrival.
- TIMES
4:15 p.m. - Field Events
4:45 p.m. - 6400 M Relay (Girls)
6:00 p.m. - 100 M. Hurdles (Girls)
- FACILITIES All-weather track (1/4" spikes). Concrete shot and discus.
- EVENTS Field events are two-person teams. One relay team per event. The field events are the same as dual meets with the addition of the triple jump. Hand in field "CARDS" at event.
- The open 100, hurdles and 1600 races will have one entrant from each team.
- SCORING Individual: 8 - 6 - 4 - 2 - 1, Relays: 8 - 6 - 4 - 2
- WEIGH-INS No Weigh-ins: All common implements.
- MANAGER/JURY The meet managers are Tracey Hiss and Shane Burrows. Take all questions to them first. The jury, if needed, will be coaches from Clyde, Perkins, and Bowling Green. The jury will function in an advisory capacity only.
- MARKINGS The track may be marked with tennis balls **ONLY** - provided. PLEASE, **DO NOT** use tape or chalk!! Runways may be marked to the side of the runway ONLY. Do not dig out!!
- RESULTS The results and awards will be available in the press box 10 minutes after the conclusion of the 4 x 400 M. relay.
- 2012 RELAYS Invitations for the 2013 Pirate Relays will be (**FRIDAY MAY3rd**) sent to this year's participating teams first. You will be asked to accept or reject by the end of the school year.
- BULL PEN Turn in the cards for 1600 M. run, hurdles, and 100 M. run in at the START. Relay cards for all other races shall be turned into the clerk at the bull pen area at the FIRST call. Runners will be sent to the exchange zones directly from the bull pen. Please put first and last names on cards.

FIELD EVENTS SCHEDULE

- TWO PERSON TEAMS -

GIRLS

LONG JUMP – Begins at 4:15 (four jumps per person)

Flight #1 - Clyde, Edison, and Bowling Green

Flight #2 – Sandusky and Perkins

HIGH JUMP - Starts at 4:15. Starting height 4'2" then up 2"

* In the high jump, instruct your athletes that they MUST be excused by the judge. We will jump out of order if necessary, but the bar will not be lowered, nor will we tolerate needless delays - Leave at LAST call ONLY!!

SHOT PUT - After boys (about 5:00). Four puts per person

DISCUS - Begins at 4:15 (four throws per person)

Flight #1 - Bowling Green, Sandusky, Perkins

Flight #2 - Edison, and Clyde

POLE VAULT - Starts at 4:15. Starting height 6', then 7', then up 6" until completed

TRIPLE JUMP - Begins after long jump (about 5:15)

Four jumps per person - Flights same as the long jump

BOYS

LONG JUMP – Begins at 4:15 (four jumps per person)

Flight #1 - Clyde, Edison, and Sandusky

Flight #2 - Bowling Green and Perkins

HIGH JUMP - Starts at 4:15. Starting height 5'4" then up 2" thereafter

* In the high jump, instruct your athletes that they MUST be excused by the judge. We will jump out of order if necessary, but the bar will not be lowered, nor will we tolerate needless delays - Leave at LAST call ONLY!!

SHOT PUT - Starts at 4:15. Four puts per person

DISCUS - After girls (about 5:00). Four throws per person

Flight #1 - Bowling Green, Sandusky, Perkins

Flight #2 –Edison and Clyde

* The above flights are for SHOT and DISCUS *

POLE VAULT - Starts at 4:15. Starting height 9', then 10', then up 6" until completed

TRIPLE JUMP - Begins after long jump (about 5:15)

Four jumps per person - Flights same as the long jump

REMEMBER - There is a separate trophy for the team winner of the FIELD EVENTS!

The above listed times are only approximations based on last year. We will start the girls 100 meter hurdles at 6:00 p.m., then continue without a break to the conclusion. From past experience, these times will be very close. Listen to the PA for the first call of each event, then report to the bull pen area.

BREAKING TIES IN FIELD EVENTS

Tie Breaking:

Long Jump - Triple Jump - Shot - Discus

1. Longest effort
2. 2nd longest effort
3. 3rd longest effort, etc.

High Jump - Pole Vault

1. Highest jump made
2. Total misses of jumpers
3. Jump off: 1 per school
1 attempt at last height missed

Up (1" H.J. - 3" P.V) if both make; Down 1"
if both miss, until there is a winner.

Jumping order as listed on field event order sheet

Only one attempt each at each height.

** There shall be NO TIES in the field events.

** Any heights made in a jump-off shall not count towards the total team height or record.

NOTES:

There will be 5 minutes of run-throughs or practice throws **between** flights!

You have **1 minute** to throw or jump when called "up" by the judge!

REMEMBER - There is a TEAM trophy for the highest team point total in the field events.

RELAYS

SPRINT (100 - 100 - 200 - 400)

DISTANCE (800 - 400 - 1200 - 1600)

PIRATE RELAYS

OUTSTANDING MALE & FEMALE PERFORMER

SCORING:

1. Same as relay events (10 - 8 - 6 - 4 - 2 - 1)
2. If athlete's time, distance, or height breaks a meet record, add 5 points to the total.
3. If athlete's time, distance, or height ties a meet record, add 2 points to the total.

If a tie among athletes remains after the above are added up, the winner shall be determined by the following formula:

- A. The one with the most first place finishes.
- B. The one with the most number of seconds, etc.
- C. The one that had the most record breaking efforts.
- D. If the tie still remains, duplicate awards will be given.

NOTE: Obviously, these points scored toward the M.V.P. award do NOT count on the TEAM total!!
