## Meet Information

Spikes – 1/8” spikes only

All events but the 100 dash, 100/110 Hurdles, 200 dash and the 300 Hurdles will be clerked on the turf on the home sideline. The 100 dash, the 100/110 hurdles, and the 200 dash will be clerked on the high jump pad. The 300 hurdles will be clerked at the 300 hurdles starting line.

Due to a surveying error the Plymouth track is set up a little different. Instead of having a common finish line for the 100/110 hurdles we have a common starting line and a different finish line for the 110 hurdles. Please make sure that your athletes are aware of this.

Starting Heights – Girls high jump – 3’10” Boys high jump – 4’10”

All runners should report to the home sideline turf prior to the second call. Field events report in at the event site.

Relay teams should use tennis balls to designate their starting marks. Chalk or Tennis balls may be used for high jump. Please DO NOT mark on all weather surface with tape.

The 4 x 800, 800, 1600, and 3200 will use a one turn stagger. The 4 x 400 relay will use a three turn stagger.

Long jump, shot put, and discus will have 4 jumps or throws.

Meet results will be available as soon as possible after the meet. Results will be posted to Baumspage before you arrive home from the meet.

Once the field events are completed, we want all athletes out of the infield. Coaches will have access to the infield and field event areas throughout the meet.

Spectators- There will be no limit to the number of spectators at this track meet. The Plymouth Athletic Department feels that track is a sport that lets spectators naturally socially distance. We do however ask spectators to wear masks when not eating and when sitting in the stands to sit in family pods.

Athletes are reminded to social distance and wear masks when not warming up for, competing in or cooling down from an event.

A concession stand will be open throughout the meet.
