ENTERING MARKS – Entries must be made via baumspage. Please enter times and distances achieved this season if possible. This will ensure that each athlete will be placed in the proper heat or flight.

SCRATCHES or CHANGES – There will be a coaches meeting in the football locker room near the new restrooms at the south end of the track at 9:30AM. Scratches/changes may be made at this time.

MEET SCHEDULE

9:30 Coaches Meeting

10:00 Girls pole vault / Boys pole vault to follow
Boys high jump / Girls high jump to follow
Boys shot put / Girls discus – 2 flights of teams
Boys & Girls long jump simultaneously using 2 pits

NOTE: 4 jumps/throws (no finals) for LJ/Shot/Discus

11:00 Distance Medley Relay (girls' first) 800-400-1200-1600

12:00 Running Event Finals – Regular OHSAA meet order

As in the past, we will be using timed finals in the high hurdles, 100 and 200 instead of having semi-finals in those events.

SCORING – 8 Places = 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1, Ribbons to Top 6 Placers Only
Meet this year will again be timed via F.A.T. timing/scoring system

Spikes – 1/8" spikes only

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Starting Heights – Girls pole vault – 6'0" Boys pole vault – 8'0"
 Girls high jump – 4'0" Boys high jump – 5'0"

All runners should report to the bullpen at the northwest corner of the track prior to the second call. Field events report at the event site.

Relay teams should use tennis balls to designate their starting marks. Tape may be used in the high jump area only. Please remove your tape at the completion of jumping.

The 4 x 800, 800, 1600, and 3200 will use a one turn stagger. The 4 x 400 relay will use a three turn stagger. Possibly multiple heats in the 800...to be determined.

Long jump, shot put, and discus will consist of 4 jumps/throws. No finals.

Awards will be put in a packet for coaches to pick up after the meet. Meet results will be available as soon as possible after the meet.

Team camps may be setup under the home (west) bleachers or in the visitors (east) bleachers. Teams must refrain from using areas marked off-limits due to conditions of recent construction.

Once the field events are completed, we need all athletes out of the infield. Coaches will have access to the infield and field event areas throughout the meet. Due to construction issues, athletes and coaches are instructed to use caution when moving around the facility.

A concession stand will be open throughout the meet.

Team Bus Parking – A reserved area of LOT C will be designated for team bus drop-off and parking. Team buses should access parking LOT C using Plymouth Street (see attached map). Shelby personnel will be present to assist with team drop-off and parking.

NOTE: **Smiley Avenue**, between North Gamble St and Broadway St in the City of Shelby, will be closed starting **Monday, April 3rd** and will remain closed for **ninety (90) days**, weather permitting. The closure will allow for a bridge replacement project.
