## 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual "Tom Iwan" Solon Comet Invitational

**Start times:** Field events will begin at 4:00. Running events will begin at 5:00.

**Bus Drop-off and Parking:** Buses should drop athletes and equipment off at the northeast/visitor gate. Buses can then park on the west/home side of the stadium. Athletes can be picked up on that side at the end of the meet.

**Ticket Sales:** Tickets (\$5) will be sold at the visitor's gate. This will be the only gate open. It is located at the northeast end of the stadium. Cash, credit, and debit cards will be accepted.

Concessions: Concessions will be available on both the home and away sides of the stadium.

Meet Entries: Due on Baumspage on TH 5/5 @ 10:00 AM.

Entries per event: This meet can have different purposes for different teams – setting your postseason roster, fine-tuning relays, giving young athletes a chance to compete in an Invitational setting, going for a team win. With that said, every team has up to 4 entries in all individual sprint events, 3 entries in all individual distance events, 2 entries for all relays (including the 4x800M), and 4 field event entries (except for the Pole Vault – that will be limited to 3 entries per school).

Scratches/Subs: Scratches and substitutions can be made before the start of the meet at the finish line until 4:30 pm.

**Clerk/check-in:** Athletes should check-in at the bullpen area (south end of the stadium) for all events except for the 300H and the 200M. Athletes will check in at the starting line for those events. Field events check in at the specific field event area.

**Team Camps:** Please use the West – Home bleachers for your team camps and reserve the East – Visitor bleachers for spectators.

Warm-up Area: Athletes may use the infield area to warm-up. The infield is for active warm up only.

Coaches' Hospitality: Will be available throughout the meet in the visitor's locker room behind the away stands.

## **Field Events:**

Long Jump, boys followed by the girls

*Discus,* boys followed by the girls. *Shot Put,* girls followed by the boys.

High Jump, girls followed by the boys.

- -Girls' starting height is 4'0, and progression will be determined by High Jump official (most likely 3-inches).
- -Boys' starting height is 5'0, and progression will be determined by the High Jump official (most likely 3-inches).

Pole Vault, girls followed by the boys.

- -Girls' starting height will be 7-0, and progression will be determined by the Pole Vault official.
- -Boys' starting height will be 9-0, and progression will be determined by the Pole Vault official.

**Scoring:** For individual events, 10-8-6-4-2-1. For relays, while schools can enter two relay teams, only one can count toward the team total. The scoring for relays will be 10-8-6-4-2.

**Awards:** Team champion and runner-up trophy. Dry-fit t-shirts will be awarded to all 1<sup>st</sup> place finishers. Cotton t-shirts will be awarded to all 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers.
