Entries

Two participants per event, one relay team per school in each of the relays. Entries must be submitted through www.baumspage.com by 10:00 pm on Tuesday, May 9th. There will be no scratch window.

Heats & Lane Assignments

Lane Assignments will be open draw in the 3200m relay, 800m, 1600m and 3200m. Athletes will be assigned for all other races by the times submitted.

Starting Heights

The starting heights for all field events will be determined by the games committee. Please list consistent heights.

Discus/Shot Put

Implement weigh-ins will take place at 3:30 pm in the shed under the southwest stands. All legal implements will be marked for competition, while the illegal implements will be retained until the end of the meet.

Discus/Long Jump/Shot Put

Two flights with 3 attempts. Top 9 performers will advance to the finals where they will be awarded three more attempts.

Team Scoring

We will score 8 places for this meet (10,8,6,5,4,3,2,1).

Excused Athletes

No athlete should check out until after the second call for that event has been made. The athlete should report back immediately at the conclusion of the event. The event judge will grant the athlete a rest period. An athlete may request consecutive attempts.

Clerk/Bull Pen

Turn in relay cards to the clerk. The bull pen will be located on northwest side of the track – behind the starting line for the 100 meter dash.

Timing System/Hip Numbers

We will be using fully automatic timing with 8 back-up hand timers. Athletes should get their hip number at the table near the bull pen before checking in with the clerk. Remind athletes to put the hip number on the SIDE of the right hip. All individual runners and relay anchor legs need hip numbers.

Coaches Box

A coaches' box will be provided for all field events.

Coaches Meeting

All coaches are asked to report to the southwest coach's office at 3:30 pm on Wednesday afternoon.

Awards

Awards will be given to coaches to distribute at the conclusion of the meet.

Inclement Weather

In the event of inclement weather the Whitmer Field House will be used to shelter athletes and spectators.

Trainers

A certified trainer will be available at the meet and will be positioned in the infield near the finish line.

Facilities

Facilities are available, but teams are encouraged to come to the meet dressed to compete. The Whitmer track is an 8 lane all-weather track, with all-weather surfaces at the jumping areas as well. Teams will not be allowed to use chalk for marking however tape and tennis balls will be allowed. Teams should also supply their own batons.

Footwear

Spikes are not to be worn in the bleachers. Please use 1/8 or 1/4 inch spikes only.

Seating

Seating will be available on the west side of the track. Spectators should be reminded of the following:

- Air Horns will not be permitted
- Smoking or Alcohol consumption will not be tolerated
- Banners and/or signs are welcome so long as they are not personal, negative, unsportsmanlike or obstruct the view of other spectators.

Bus Parking

Buses are to drop teams off at the entrance to the track and proceed to the parking lot across from Jefferson Junior High School – located southwest of the track.

Team Camps

All Team Camps will be located on the grass directly south of the Track. We ask that everyone please be respectful of our facilities and to pick up all trash at the conclusion of each night.

Infield

The infield is to remain clear of unauthorized persons. The only persons who will have access to the infield at any given time will be the coaches and officials. There will be a warm-up area for runners in the north end zone only. Please encourage your athletes to stay off of the rest of the turf.

Rules and Regulations

The rules governing this championship, other than those stated herein, will be the official rules of the Ohio High School Athletic Association and the Three Rivers Athletic Conference regulations listed below.

Article XXV – Track and Field – Boys and Girls

- 25-1-1. Varsity and JV track and field will be contested in the Three Rivers Athletic Conference with the team champions and conference standings determined by a conference championship meet. The host school for the championship meet will be determined by the conference adopted rotation schedule. Should a member school not have a site suitable for conducting the conference championship meet they shall make this known one year in advance and the next school in the rotation will host the following meet. The conference varsity championship meet will be held on Wednesday and Friday the week prior to the Ohio High School Athletic Association District Meet. The conference JV meet will be held on the Saturday following the varsity championship meet.
- 25-1-2. Each school may enter two participants in each event at the championship meet. Athletes, including seniors, may participate in the JV championship meet individual events so long as they do not participate in the varsity championship meet individual event. JV athletes may run up on relay teams in the varsity championship meet.
- 25-1-3. The championship meet will be conducted under the rules and regulations established by the Ohio High School Athletic Association.
- 25-1-4. A meet director will be designated by the host school.
