Start time: Field events 9:30 a.m., Running events 10:00 a.m.

Competition: Two competitors or one relay per event.

Admission: All Tickets are \$6. Please try to limit to six tickets per student-athlete. No passcode needed. They will be sold only presale and online via HomeTown Ticketing: <https://www.midviewk12.org/Tickets.aspx>

COVID-19 Precautions: Everyone (Athletes, Coaches and Fans) must symptom check at home and not come if they are sick. All Spectators, Coaches and Non-active participants must wear a mask at all times, socially distance and follow all stadium signage.

Coaches Packets: You may pick up your coaches packet at the pass gate at arrival

Coaches Meeting: There will be a brief coaches meeting near the finish line to answer any questions at approximately 8:50 a.m. **(Please remember to provide a copy of your roster and a copy of the OHSAA Coaches Verification form at this meeting).**

Participation Areas: Discus is located on the east side of the stadium. Shot put is located in the southwest corner of the stadium. Long jump and pole vault are located in the south east corner of the stadium and can be accessed by the visitors stands. High jump will be on the south D-zone of the track.

Jury of Appeals: There will be no jury of appeals. All decisions made by the referee shall be final.

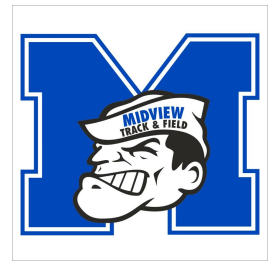
Track and Track Markings: Maximum spike length for the running events and high jump pole vault and long jump will be 1/4". Starting blocks will be furnished. Tennis ball halves, tongue depressors may be used as markers for the relays. Tape may be used at the High Jump or alongside the Pole Vault and Long Jump runway. **NO CHALK WILL BE PERMITTED.**

Scoring: All events are scored 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. All events will utilize Fully Automatic Timing.



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Field Events: All athletes will report to the event official for sign in prior to the first call. Warm-up may begin at 9:00am. Shot Put, Discus and Long Jump competitors will receive 4 attempts. The best effort will be used for scoring. Ties will be resolved by the official utilizing National Federation Rules. All Discus and Shot Puts will be weighed in the football barn on the west side of the stadium.

Field Event Starting Heights:

Boys High Jump: 4'3", 4'6", 4'8", 4'10", 5', 5'2", 5'4", 5'6" (as determined by competitors)

Girls High Jump: 3'6", 3'8", 3'10", 4'0", 4'2", 4'4", 4'6" (as determined by competitors)

***Boys Pole Vault:** 6', 6'6", 7', 7'6", 8', 8'6", 9' (as determined by competitors)

***Girls Pole Vault:** 6', 6'6", 7', 7'6", 8', 8'6", 9' (as determined by competitors)

***Please remember to provide a copy of the OHSAA Pole Vault Verification Form to the event official.**

Shotput and Discus: 4 throws all finals **Boys and Girls Long Jump:** 4 jumps. All Finals. Open Pit completed by 11:30.

Awards: Medals shall be awarded for 1st through 3rd place. Ribbons will be provided for 4th-8th place. Team trophies will be awarded for Boys and Girls Team Champions and Runners-Up. Individual awards shall be placed in a bag and coaches may begin to pick them up in the press box at the conclusion of the meet. **Please make sure you don't forget your athletes' awards!**

Restrooms: Restrooms will be available and are located in the north end of the stadium.

Athletic Trainer: Our athletic trainer will be stationed by the finish line to administer first aid. Taping will be available; however, you must provide your own supplies.

Concessions: Midview Track and Field will be running our concessions stand which is located on the north end of the stadium.

T-shirts: T-shirts will be on sale inside the gate.

Team Areas: Teams may set up their camps in the **VISITOR'S** stands or in the grassy areas on the northeast side of the stadium. **NO CAMPS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE HOME STANDS.** These seats will be reserved for spectators. **Please clean up your team area before leaving.**

Bullpen: The bullpen will be located at the north end of the straightaway.

Spectators will be permitted to view the Shot Put and Discus from the viewing stands provided or outside of the fence surrounding each area. **Absolutely no spectators will be permitted inside the competition area. No athletes will be permitted on the infield!**
